This Bill is cognate with the Workers' Compensation (Amendment) Bill, 1981.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Workers' Compensation (Dust Diseases)

Act, 1942, so as to—

- (a) make provisions with respect to the audit by the Auditor-General of certain accounts under that Act (Schedule 1 (1));
- (b) bring that Act into line with the Workers' Compensation Act, 1926, by-
 - (i) increasing, with effect from 17th December, 1980, certain amounts payable under that Act on the death of a worker (Schedule 1 (2) (a), (b));
 - (ii) providing for the indexation of those amounts (Schedule 1 (2) (c), (d)),

and to enact certain savings and transitional provisions (Schedule 2).

A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the Workers' Compensation (Dust Diseases) Act, 1942, to increase, with effect from 17th December, 1980, certain amounts payable under that Act on the death of a worker; and for certain other purposes.

[MR WALKER—29 April, 1981.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Workers' Compensation (Dust Diseases) Amendment Act, 1981".

Commencement.

- 2. (1) Except as provided in subsections (2)–(4), this Act shall commence 10 on the date of assent to this Act.
 - (2) Section 4 shall, in its application to a provision of Schedule 1, commence or be deemed to have commenced on the day on which that provision commences or is deemed to have commenced, as the case may require.
- 15 (3) Section 5 shall, in its application to a provision of Schedule 2, commence or be deemed to have commenced on the day on which that provision commences or is deemed to have commenced, as the case may require.
- (4) Schedule 1 (2) and clauses 1 and 2 of Schedule 2 shall be deemed 20 to have commenced on 17th December, 1980.

SAVINGS AND TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS.

15 Compensation payable on death of worker.

1. The compensation prescribed by the provisions of section 8 (2B) (b) (i) of the Workers' Compensation (Dust Diseases) Act, 1942, as amended by this Act and as construed in accordance with section 8 (3) of the Workers' Compensation (Dust Diseases) Act, 1942, as amended by this Act, is payable in accordance with those 20 provisions, as so amended and construed, in respect of the death of a worker which, on or after 17th December, 1980, results from an injury whether received before, on or after that date.

Weekly payments.

The weekly payments prescribed by section 8 (2B) (b) (iii) of the Workers'
 Compensation (Dust Diseases) Act, 1942, as amended by this Act and as construed in accordance with section 8 (3) of the Workers' Compensation (Dust Diseases) Act, 1942, as amended by this Act, are payable on and from 17th December, 1980, in respect of all persons who, immediately before that date, were in receipt of or entitled to weekly payments under the provisions of section 8 (2B) (b) (iii) of the Workers'
 Compensation (Dust Diseases) Act, 1942, as well as to all persons becoming entitled to weekly payments under those provisions on or after that date.

 - (b) the words "be construed as \$60.20 and \$18.10 respectively" were omitted therefrom and the words "be construed as \$17,350, \$60.20 and \$21 respectively" were inserted instead thereof.

Act No. 74, 1981.

An Act to amend the Workers' Compensation (Dust Diseases) Act, 1942, to increase, with effect from 17th December, 1980, certain amounts payable under that Act on the death of a worker; and for certain other purposes. [Assented to, 28th May, 1981.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Workers' Compensation (Dust Diseases) Amendment Act, 1981".

Commencement.

- **2.** (1) Except as provided in subsections (2)–(4), this Act shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.
- (2) Section 4 shall, in its application to a provision of Schedule 1, commence or be deemed to have commenced on the day on which that provision commences or is deemed to have commenced, as the case may require.
- (3) Section 5 shall, in its application to a provision of Schedule 2, commence or be deemed to have commenced on the day on which that provision commences or is deemed to have commenced, as the case may require.
- (4) Schedule 1 (2) and clauses 1 and 2 of Schedule 2 shall be deemed to have commenced on 17th December, 1980.

SAVINGS AND TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS.

Compensation payable on death of worker.

1. The compensation prescribed by the provisions of section 8 (2B) (b) (i) of the Workers' Compensation (Dust Diseases) Act, 1942, as amended by this Act and as construed in accordance with section 8 (3) of the Workers' Compensation (Dust Diseases) Act, 1942, as amended by this Act, is payable in accordance with those provisions, as so amended and construed, in respect of the death of a worker which, on or after 17th December, 1980, results from an injury whether received before, on or after that date.

Weekly payments.

2. The weekly payments prescribed by section 8 (2B) (b) (iii) of the Workers' Compensation (Dust Diseases) Act, 1942, as amended by this Act and as construed in accordance with section 8 (3) of the Workers' Compensation (Dust Diseases) Act, 1942, as amended by this Act, are payable on and from 17th December, 1980, in respect of all persons who, immediately before that date, were in receipt of or entitled to weekly payments under the provisions of section 8 (2B) (b) (iii) of the Workers' Compensation (Dust Diseases) Act, 1942, as well as to all persons becoming entitled to weekly payments under those provisions on or after that date.

SAVINGS AND TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS—continued.

Adjustable amounts.

- 3. The declaration made by the Registrar of the Workers' Compensation Commission pursuant to section 8 (3) of the Workers' Compensation (Dust Diseases) Act, 1942, and published on page 1597 of the Gazette of 13th March, 1981, shall be deemed to have been made as if—
 - (a) the words "the adjustable amounts of \$46.50 and \$14.00 referred to in section 8 (2B) (b) (ii) or (iii)" were omitted therefrom and the words "the adjustable amounts of \$16,500, \$46.50 and \$20 referred to in section 8 (2B) (b) (i), (ii) or (iii)" were inserted instead thereof; and
 - (b) the words "be construed as \$60.20 and \$18.10 respectively" were omitted therefrom and the words "be construed as \$17,350, \$60.20 and \$21 respectively" were inserted instead thereof.
