BANK OF NEW SOUTH WALES (CHANGE OF NAME) BILL, 1982

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with The Commercial Bank of Australia Limited (Merger) Bill, 1982.

The objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to change the name of the Bank of New South Wales to “Westpac Banking Corporation”; and
- (b) to make provisions of a consequential, ancillary or saving nature.

The Bill contains the following provisions:—

Clause 1. Short title.

Clause 2. Commencement.

Clause 3. Interpretation.

Clause 4 changes the name of the banking company constituted by the Bank of New South Wales Act of 1850 to “Westpac Banking Corporation”.

Clause 5 makes provisions of a saving nature as a consequence of that change of name.

Clause 6 provides that certain references to “The Bank of New South Wales” or “Bank of New South Wales” shall, on and from the change of the name of the banking company referred to in clause 4, be read and construed as references to “Westpac Banking Corporation”.

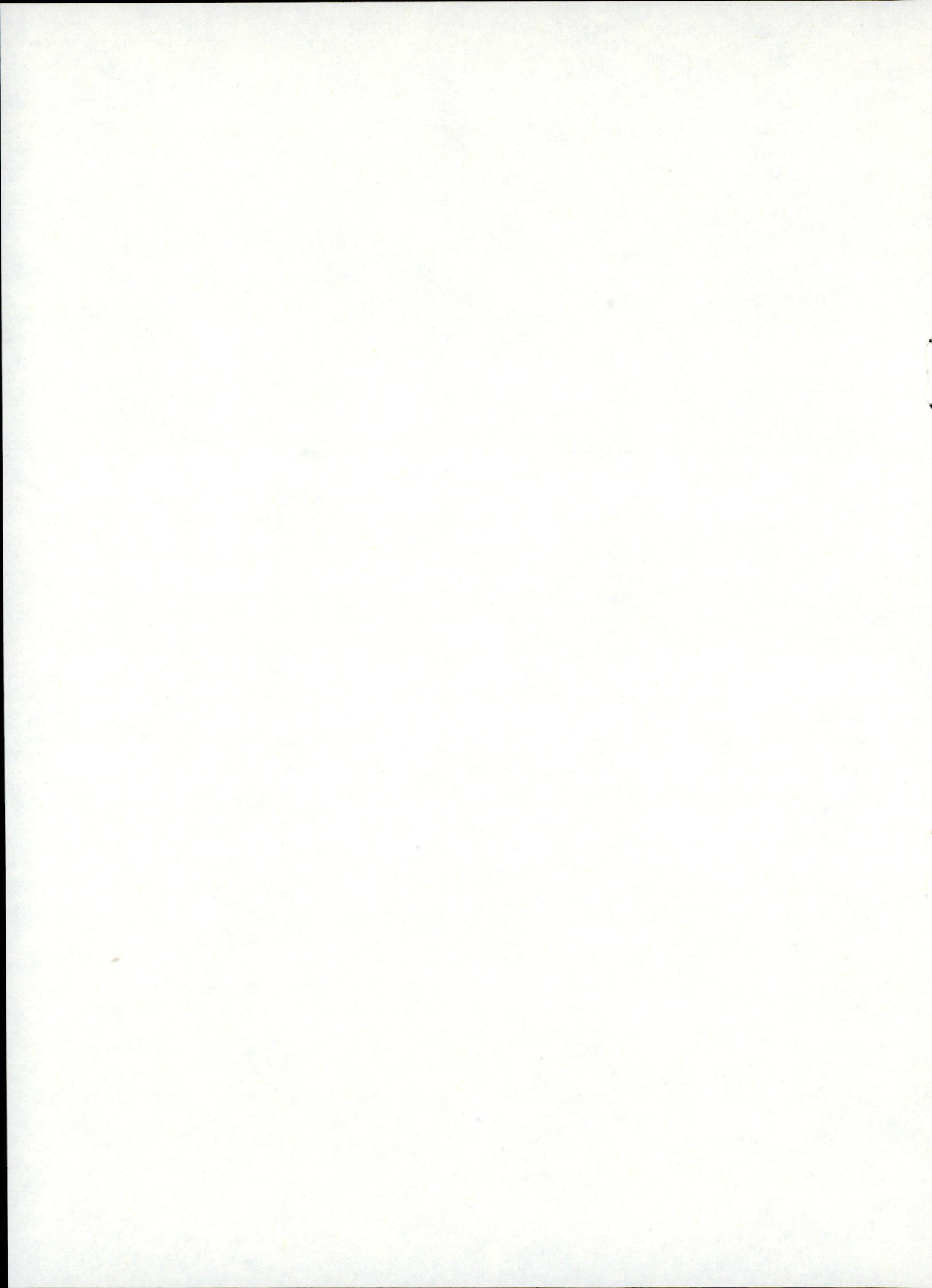

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Bank of New South Wales (Change of Name) Act, 1982".
