COMMUNITY WELFARE (PRIVATE HEALTH ESTABLISHMENTS) AMENDMENT BILL, 1982

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Private Health Establishments Bill, 1982.

The object of this Bill is to exclude from the licensing requirements of the Community Welfare Act, 1982, certain residential centres for handicapped persons which are to be licensed under the proposed Private Health Establishments Act, 1982.

A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section 4 of the Community Welfare Act, 1982, as a consequence of the enactment of the Private Health Establishments Act, 1982.

Community Welfare (Private Health Establishments) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Community Welfare (Private Health Establishments) Amendment Act, 1982".

Commencement.

2. (1) Sections 1 and 2 shall commence on the date of assent to this
10 Act.

(2) Except as provided by subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Private Health Establishments Act, 1982.

Amendment of Act No. 76, 1982.

15 3. The Community Welfare Act, 1982, is amended by omitting paragraph (b) of the definition of "exempt premises" in section 4 (1) and by inserting instead the following paragraph:—

20 (b) a private hospital or nursing home licensed under the Private Health Establishments Act, 1982, or a residential centre for handicapped persons within the meaning of Division 2 of Part XI which—

(i) is located in the same building as such a private hospital or nursing home; or

(ii) adjoins premises which are such a private hospital or nursing home;
