Land and Environment Court (Community Welfare) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Land and Environment Court (Community Welfare) Amendment Act, 1982".

Commencement.

2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to 10 this Act.

(2) Except as provided by subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Community Welfare Act, 1982.

Amendment of Act No. 204, 1979.

15 3. The Land and Environment Court Act, 1979, is amended by inserting after section 64 (2) the following subsection:—

20 (3) Without affecting the generality of subsection (1), the Minister administering the Community Welfare Act, 1982, may, at any stage of any proceedings before the Court in which a non-Government organisation within the meaning of that Act is a party, with the consent of that organisation, intervene by counsel, solicitor or agent, and may examine witnesses and address the Court with respect to matters relevant to the proceedings.

An Act to amend section 64 of the Land and Environment Court Act, 1979, so as to enable the Minister administering the Community Welfare Act, 1982, to intervene in certain proceedings before the Land and Environment Court. [Assented to, 25th May, 1982.]

Land and Environment Court (Community Welfare) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Land and Environment Court (Community Welfare) Amendment Act, 1982".

Commencement.

2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Except as provided by subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Community Welfare Act, 1982.
