EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Private Health Establishments Bill, 1982.

The object of this Bill is to provide that a medical practitioner is guilty of misconduct in a professional respect if he is convicted of an offence under Part IV of the proposed Private Health Establishments Act, 1982 (which relates to the disclosure of pecuniary interests in private hospitals and nursing homes by medical practitioners).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Medical Practitioners (Private Health Establishments) Amendment Act, 1982".

Commencement.

- 2. (1) Sections 1 and 2 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.
- 10 (2) Except as provided by subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Private Health Establishments Act, 1982.






