

**MINE SUBSIDENCE COMPENSATION (AMENDMENT) BILL,
1982**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to increase from 10 per cent to 15 per cent per annum the maximum rate of interest payable on overdue contributions to the Mine Subsidence Compensation Fund ("the Fund") by proprietors of colliery holdings (Schedule 1 (1));
- (b) to provide that where a payment is made from the Fund in connection with improvements damaged by mine subsidence caused by unlawful mining operations, the Mine Subsidence Board may recover the amount of the payment from the person carrying out those mining operations (Schedule 1 (2));
- (c) to clarify the circumstances in which a person is guilty of an offence against the Mine Subsidence Compensation Act, 1961 ("the Act"), and to increase the penalty in each case to \$2,000 (Schedule 1 (3) (a)–(d), (5) (b) and (6));
- (d) to permit proceedings for offences relating to unauthorised improvements and subdivisions within mine subsidence districts to be brought within 12 months of the commission of the offence instead of 6 months (Schedule 1 (3) (e));
- (e) to provide that where the Mine Subsidence Board refuses to issue a certificate that an improvement in a mine subsidence district has been erected or altered pursuant to an approval of the Board, the Board shall notify the applicant of the refusal and of the reasons therefor (Schedule 1 (4));
- (f) to authorise members of the Mine Subsidence Board and its officers and employees to enter colliery holdings for the purposes of any inspection, examination or inquiry under the Act and to require the production of certain books and documents (Schedule 1 (5) (a));
- (g) to require all reasonable assistance and facilities to be given to enable a person to exercise his powers under the Act (Schedule 1 (5) (b));

- (h) to provide that proceedings for offences against the Act or the regulations thereunder may be disposed of before a stipendiary magistrate sitting alone instead of before such a magistrate or any 2 Justices of the Peace (Schedule 1 (6));
 - (i) to increase from \$100 to \$1,000 the maximum penalty that may be imposed for a contravention of the regulations made under the Act (Schedule 1 (7));
 - (j) to amend the Act by way of statute law revision (Schedule 2); and
 - (k) to make other amendments to the Act of a minor, ancillary or consequential nature.

Mine Subsidence Compensation (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

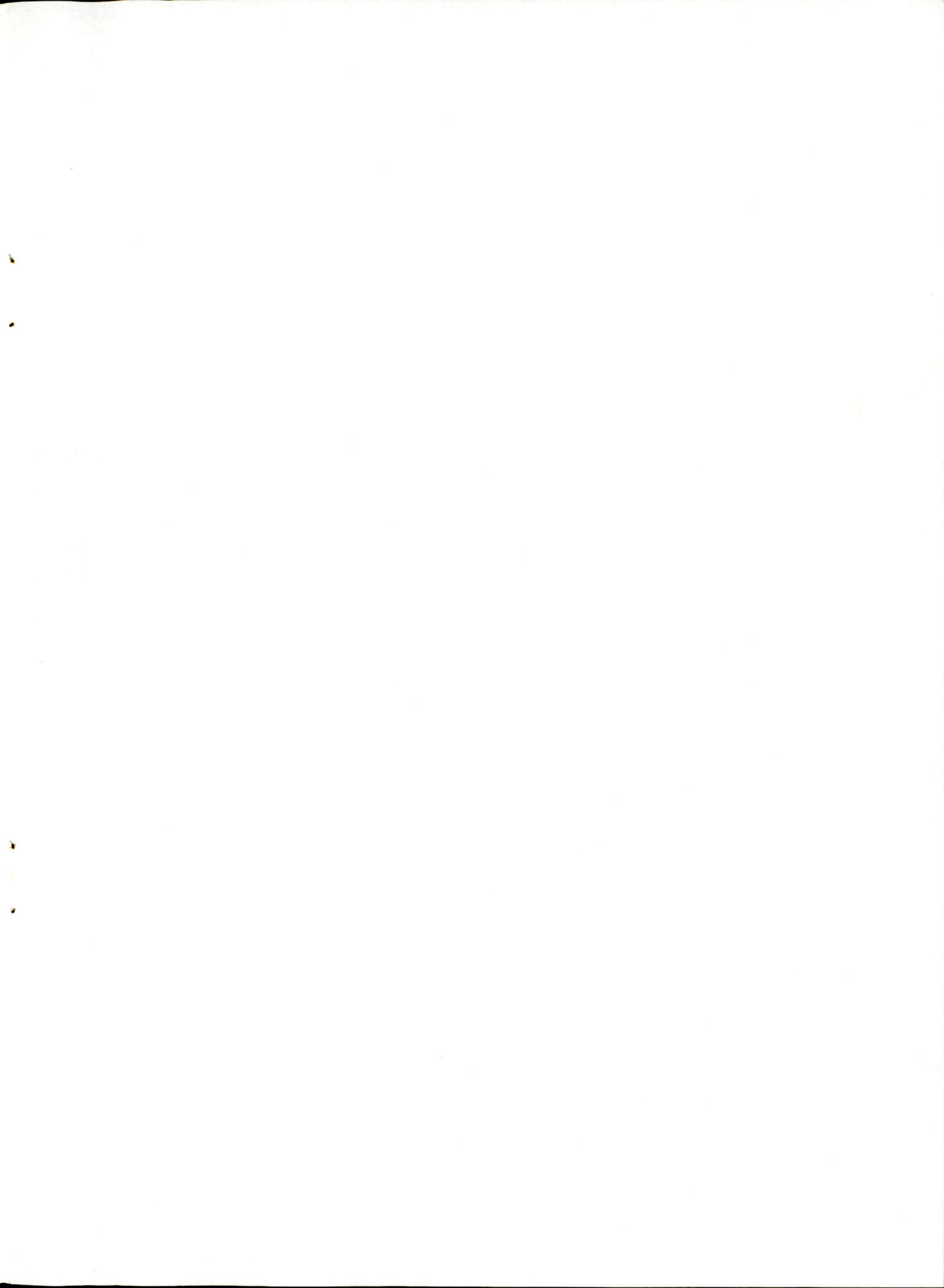
