A BILL FOR

An Act to amend various Acts as a consequence of the enactment of the Police Regulation (Deputy Commissioners) Amendment Act, 1981.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Miscellaneous Acts (Deputy Commissioners of Police) Amendment Act, 1981".

Commencement.

- 2. (1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to 10 this Act.
 - (2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Police Regulation (Deputy Commissioners) Amendment Act, 1981.



An Act to amend various Acts as a consequence of the enactment of the Police Regulation (Deputy Commissioners) Amendment Act, 1981. [Assented to, 22nd December, 1981.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Miscellaneous Acts (Deputy Commissioners of Police) Amendment Act, 1981".

Commencement.
