PUBLIC SERVICE (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1983

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The object of this Bill is to amend the Public Service Act, 1979, so as-

- (a) to provide for temporary appointments to Special Division positions in the Public Service, in a case where the position is vacant or the holder is suspended, sick or absent (Schedule 1 (1)); and
- (b) to repeal sections 73 and 74 of that Act, thereby abolishing the barrier to promotion from the lower to the higher grades of the Professional Division and the Administrative and Clerical Division of the Public Service (Schedule 1 (2)).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Public Service (Amendment) Act, 1983".

Commencement.

2. (1) Except as provided by subsection (2), this Act shall commence 10 on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Section 3, in its application to Schedule 1 (2), and Schedule 1 (2) shall commence on such day as may be appointed by the Governor in respect thereof and as may be notified by proclamation published in the Gazette.

15 **3.** The Public Service Act, 1979, is amended in the manner set forth in Schedule 1.

Transitional provision.

4. Procedures, not completed before the commencement of Schedule 1 (2), for the filling of a vacancy in a position in the Public Service may be 20 completed after that commencement as though sections 73 and 74 of the Public Service Act, 1979, were still in force, but only if—

- (a) the vacancy had been advertised in accordance with section 71 of that Act; or
- (b) a recommendation in respect of the filling of the vacancy had been made in accordance with that Act.


