

STANDARD TIME (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1982

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The object of this Bill is to extend to 4th April, 1982, the period of summer time that commenced on 25th October, 1981.

STANDARD TIME (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1982

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The explanatory note relating to this Bill as introduced into Parliament is printed at the end of the Bill. The object of the Bill is to amend the period of sunset from 31st March 1982 to 31st March 1983, and to provide that sunset shall continue to be observed on 31st March 1982.

PROOF

It is enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of the Territory of New Guinea, that the Standard Time Act, 1971, be amended as follows:—

STANDARD TIME (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1982

1. This Act may be cited as the Standard Time (Amendment) Act, 1982.

Extension of summer time in 1982.

2. Section 3 of the Standard Time Act, 1971, shall be amended as follows:—
10 of the period that commences at 2.00 am on 1 October 1971, and ends at the end of the month of March, shall be added to the time of the day.

Standard Time (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Standard Time (Amendment) Act, 1982".
