Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration (Egg Industry) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration (Egg Industry) Amendment Act, 1983".

Amendment of Act No. 4, 1976.

2. The Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration Act, 1975, is amended 10 by inserting at the end of Part 1 of Schedule 2 the following words:—

Managing Director of the New South Wales Egg Corporation.
