
STATUTORY AND OTHER OFFICES REMUNERATION (HOUSING COMMISSION) AMENDMENT BILL, 1982

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Housing (Amendment) Bill, 1982.

The object of this Bill is to make provision for the payment of remuneration to the Chief Executive of the Housing Commission of New South Wales instead of the Chairman of that Commission as a consequence of the proposed reconstitution of that Commission pursuant to the Housing (Amendment) Bill, 1982.

An Act to amend Schedule 2 to the Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration Act, 1975, as a consequence of the enactment of the Housing (Amendment) Act, 1982.

Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration (Housing Commission) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration (Housing Commission) Amendment Act, 1982".

Commencement.

- 2. (1) Except as provided by subsection (2), this Act shall commence on 10 the date of assent to this Act.
 - (2) Section 3 (2) shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Housing (Amendment) Act, 1982.

Amendment of Act No. 4, 1976.
