## TRANSPORT (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1982

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to the Bill as introduced into Parliament.)

The Bill is - *concurrent with the Transport Authorities (Amendment) Bill, 1982.*

The object of this Bill is to amend the Transport Act 1968, to ensure that certain provisions relating to the levying of certain taxes and other charges payable in respect of transport services.

Transport (Amendment)

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council with the advice and consent of the Privy Council, that the following provisions shall have effect as if they had been enacted by the authority of the Senate of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

2 Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Transport (Amendment) Act, 1982."

Commencement.

2. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), this Act shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.

10 (2) Section 3 and Schedule 1 shall be deemed to have commenced on 1st July, 1980.
