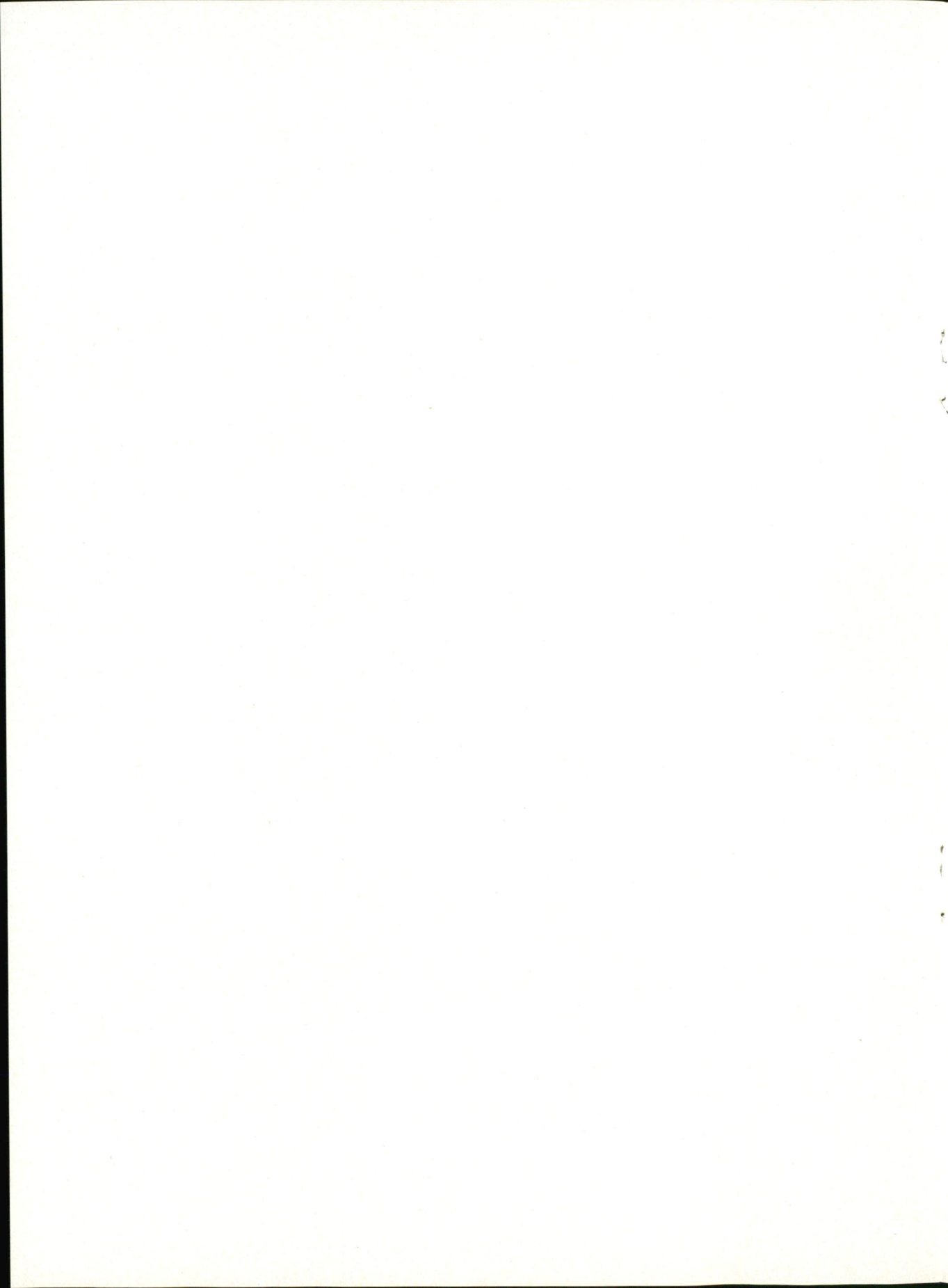
### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

**(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)**

This Bill is cognate with the Conveyancing (Powers of Attorney) Amendment Bill, 1983.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Trustee Act, 1925—

- (a) to alter a reference to certain provisions of the Conveyancing Act, 1919, in consequence of amendments made to that Act by the Conveyancing (Powers of Attorney) Amendment Act, 1983 (Schedule 1 (1)); and
  - (b) by way of statute law revision (Schedule 1 (2)).

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**5 Short title.**

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "Trustee (Powers of Attorney) Amendment Act, 1983".

**Commencement.**

**2.** This Act shall commence on the date of assent to the Conveyancing 10 (Powers of Attorney) Amendment Act, 1983.

**Amendment of Act No. 14, 1925.**

**3.** The Trustee Act, 1925, is amended in the manner set forth in Schedule 1.
