#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

## (This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The object of this Bill is to include areas of land reserved as Bare Island Historic Site, Captain Cook's Landing Place Historic Site and La Perouse Monuments Historic Site in Botany Bay National Park.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides that the proposed Act will commence on 18 January 1988.

Clause 3 provides that references in the proposed Act to the "Principal Act" are references to the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974.

Clause 4 states that expressions used in the proposed Act have the same meanings as in the Principal Act.

Clause 5 revokes the reservation of areas of land as Bare Island Historic Site, Captain Cook's Landing Place Historic Site and La Perouse Monuments Historic Site.

Clause 6 includes those areas of land in Botany Bay National Park.

Clause 7 provides that existing plans of management for the historic sites will continue to apply to the corresponding parts of the expanded Botany Bay National Park.

Schedule 1 describes the areas of land comprising the Bare Island Historic Site, Captain Cook's Landing Place Historic Site and La Perouse Monuments Historic Site.



## A BILL FOR

An Act to include Bare Island Historic Site, Captain Cook's Landing Place Historic Site and La Perouse Monuments Historic Site in Botany Bay National Park.

## The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

#### Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Botany Bay National Park Extension Act 1987.

#### 5 Commencement

2. This Act shall commence on 18 January 1988.

## **Principal Act**

3. The National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974 is referred to in this Act as the Principal Act.

## 10 Meanings of expressions

4. Expressions used in this Act have the same meanings as in the Principal Act.

#### Termination of certain historic sites

- 5. (1) The reservation of land as Bare Island Historic Site is revoked.
- 15 (2) Each reservation of land as, or as part of, Captain Cook's Landing Place Historic Site is revoked.
  - (3) The reservation of land as La Perouse Monuments Historic Site is revoked.

# Addition of land to Botany Bay National Park

- 20 6. (1) The land described in Schedule 1 is reserved as part of Botany Bay National Park.
  - (2) For the purposes of the Principal Act, the land shall be deemed to have been so reserved by a proclamation published on 18 January 1988 under section 33 (3) of that Act.
- 25 (3) Section 35 of the Principal Act does not apply to the reservation of land by this section.

## Saving of plans of management

- 7. (1) A plan of management which, immediately before 18 January 1988, applied to part of the land described in Schedule 1 shall be deemed 30 to be a plan of management adopted by the Minister for the corresponding part of Botany Bay National Park.
  - (2) Subsection (1) does not prevent the amendment, alteration, cancellation or substitution of a plan of management to which it relates.

#### **Bare Island**

 The area of land permanently reserved as Bare Island Historic Site by the National

- 2. (1) The area of land permanently reserved as Captain Cook's Landing Place Historic Site by the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1967 and described in the Third 10 Part of the Third Schedule to that Act.
  - (2) The area of land added to Captain Cook's Landing Place Historic Site by notification published in Gazette No. 157 of 13 December 1968 pursuant to the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1967.
- (3) The area of land reserved as part of Captain Cook's Landing Place Historic Site 15 by proclamation published in Gazette No. 2 of 7 January 1983 pursuant to the Principal Act.

#### La Perouse Monuments

3. The area of land permanently reserved as La Perouse Monuments Historic Site by the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1967 and described in the Third Part of the 20 Third Schedule to that Act.

# Act No. 155, 1987

An Act to include Bare Island Historic Site, Captain Cook's Landing Place Historic Site and La Perouse Monuments Historic Site in Botany Bay National Park. [Assented to 18 November 1987]

## The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

#### Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Botany Bay National Park Extension Act 1987.

#### Commencement

2. This Act shall commence on 18 January 1988.

3. The National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974 is referred to in this Act as the Principal Act.

**4.** Expressions used in this Act have the same meanings as in the Principal Act.

#### Termination of certain historic sites

- 5. (1) The reservation of land as Bare Island Historic Site is revoked.
- (2) Each reservation of land as, or as part of, Captain Cook's Landing Place Historic Site is revoked.
- (3) The reservation of land as La Perouse Monuments Historic Site is revoked.

## Addition of land to Botany Bay National Park

- 6. (1) The land described in Schedule 1 is reserved as part of Botany Bay National Park.
- (2) For the purposes of the Principal Act, the land shall be deemed to have been so reserved by a proclamation published on 18 January 1988 under section 33 (3) of that Act.

- (2) The area of land added to Captain Cook's Landing Place Historic Site by notification published in Gazette No. 157 of 13 December 1968 pursuant to the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1967.
- (3) The area of land reserved as part of Captain Cook's Landing Place Historic Site by proclamation published in Gazette No. 2 of 7 January 1983 pursuant to the Principal Act.

#### La Perouse Monuments

3. The area of land permanently reserved as La Perouse Monuments Historic Site by the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1967 and described in the Third Part of the Third Schedule to that Act.
