EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

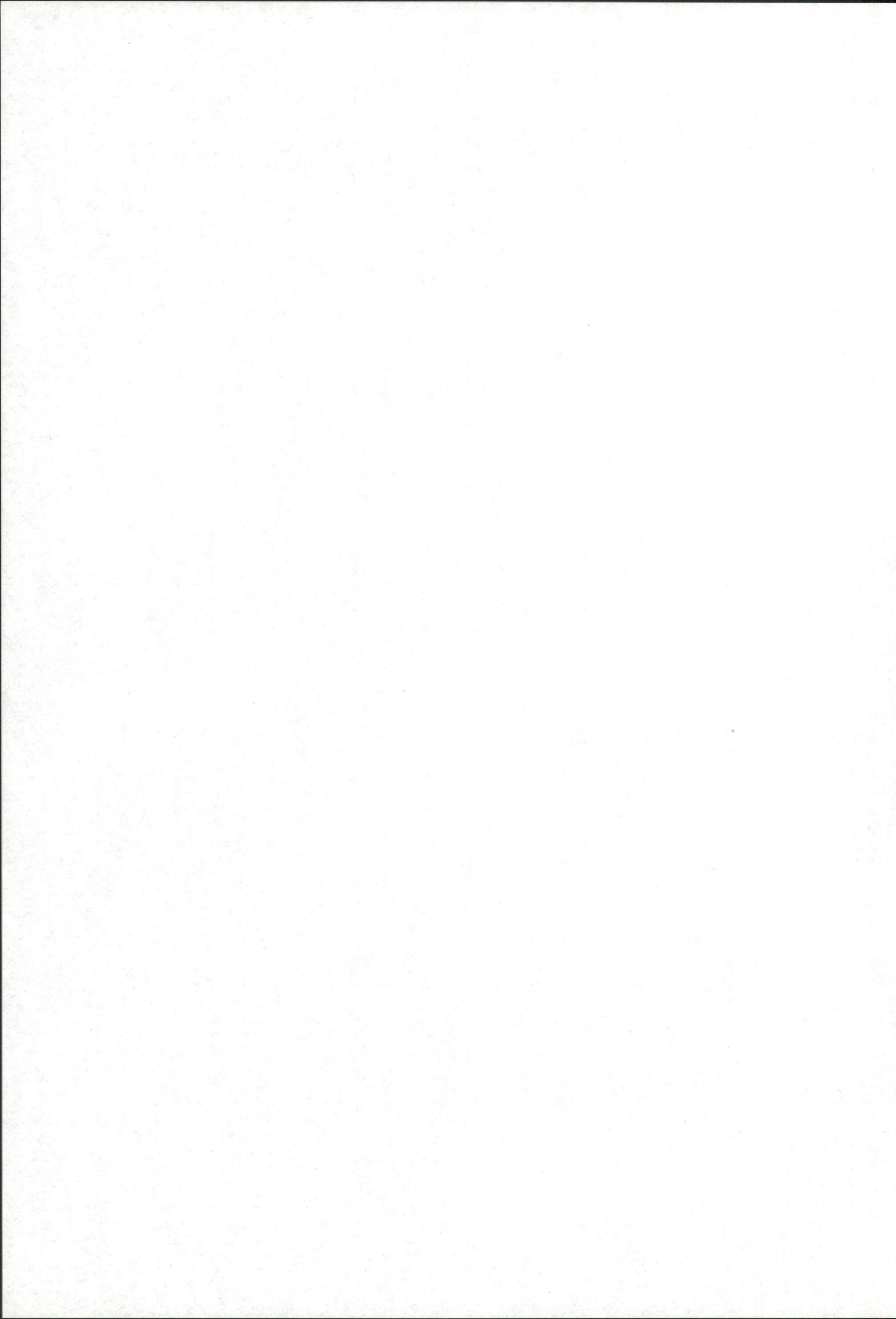
The Parliamentary Electorates and Elections (Amendment) Bill 1986 is cognate with this Bill.

The object of this Bill is to increase from 99 to 109 the number of members of the Legislative Assembly.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 (1) amends section 25 of the Constitution Act 1902 by increasing the number of members of the Legislative Assembly.

Clause 2 (2) and (3) are transitional provisions which make it clear that the amendment will operate prospectively.

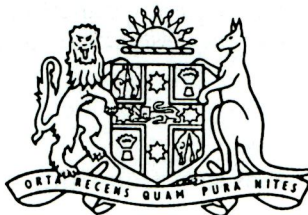

Constitution (Amendment) 1986

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

5 Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the "Constitution (Amendment) Act 1986".

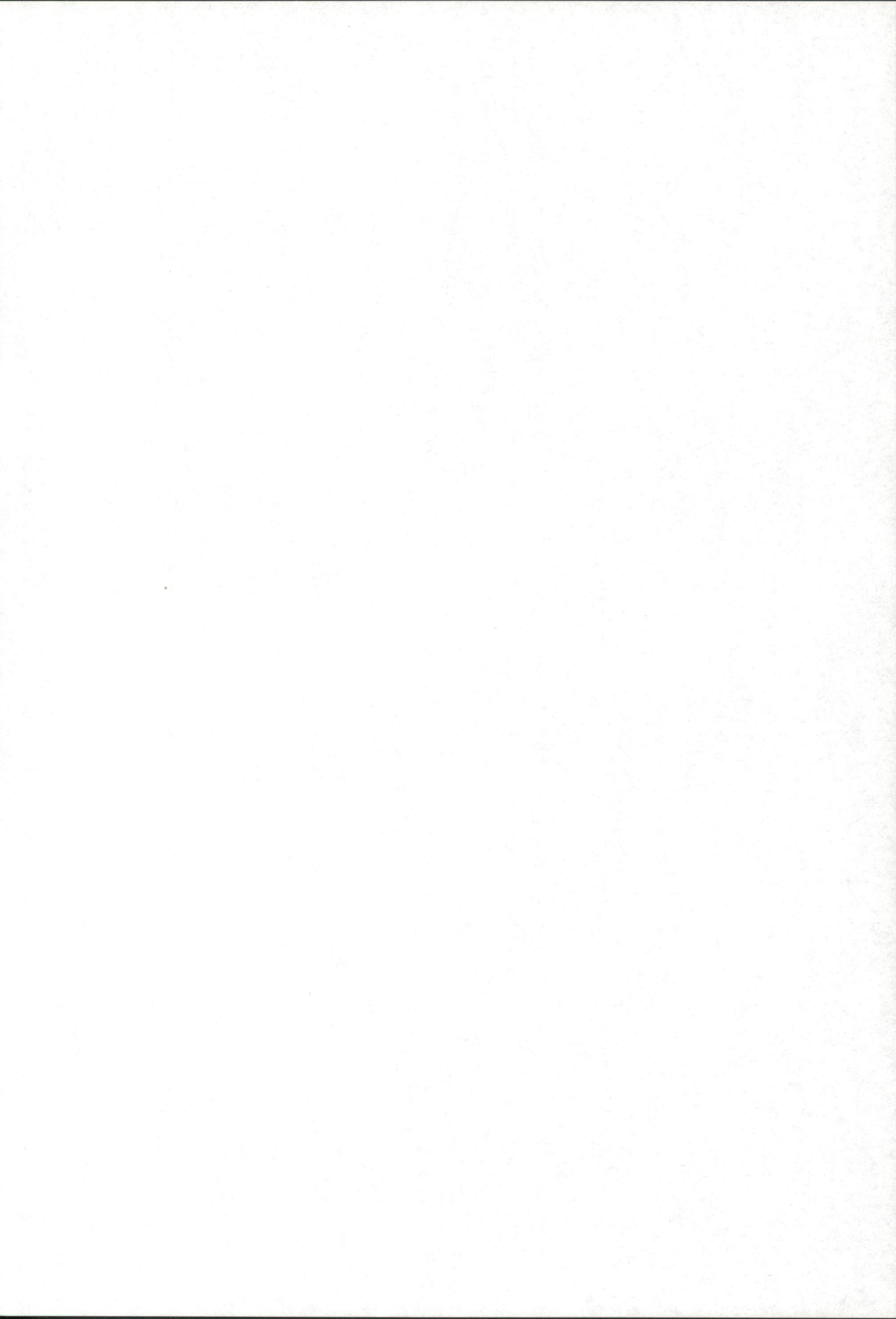
2. (1) The Constitution Act 1902 is amended by omitting from section 10 25 the figures "99" and by inserting instead the figures "109".

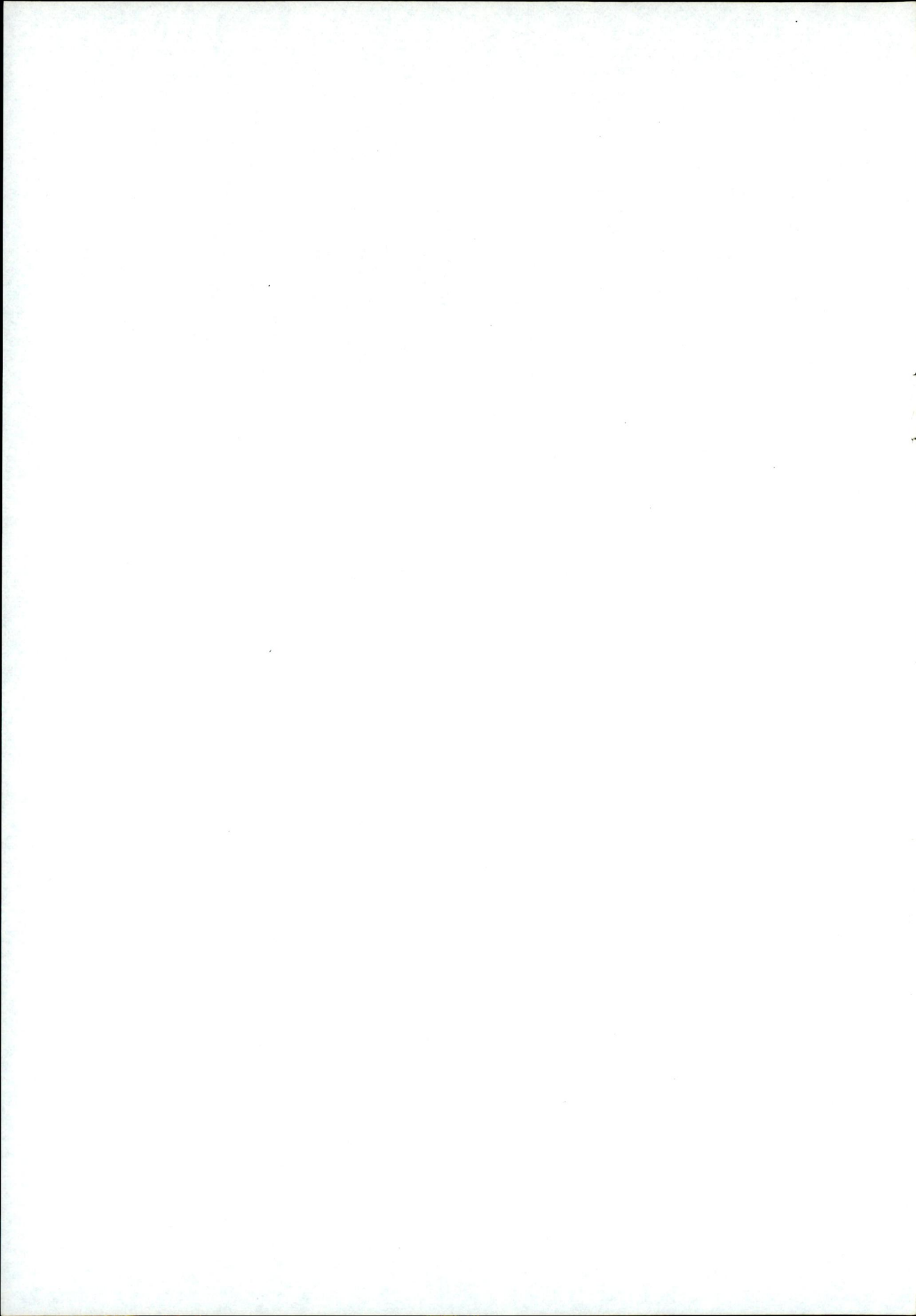
(2) For the purposes of the first distribution of electoral districts after the date of assent to this Act and of any matters necessary or incidental to that distribution, the amendment made by subsection (1) shall commence on that date.

15 (3) The amendment made by subsection (1) applies to and in respect of the number of Members of the Legislative Assembly to be returned at the general election to be held next after the distribution referred to in subsection (2), and shall come into force for all purposes as on and from that general election.

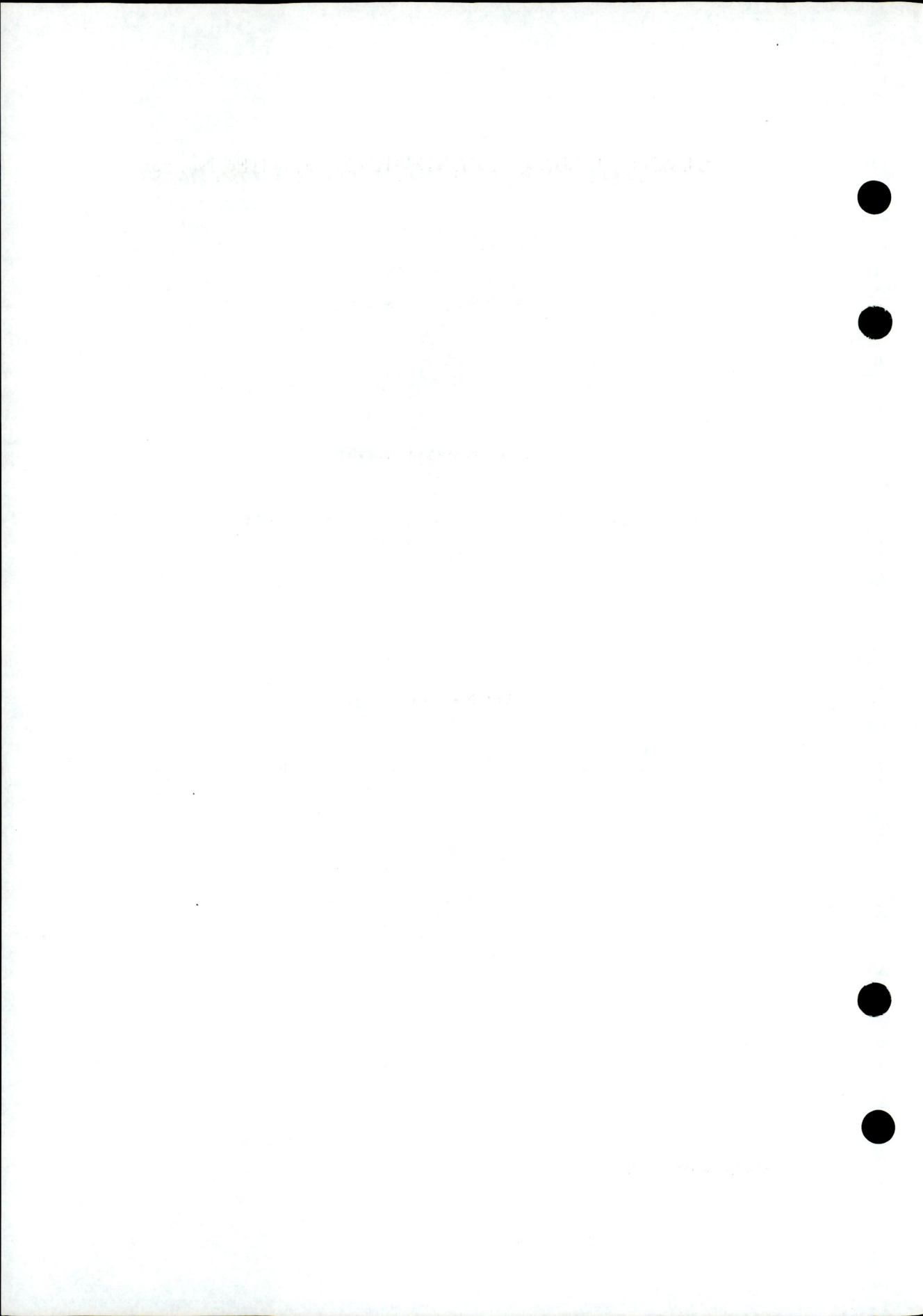

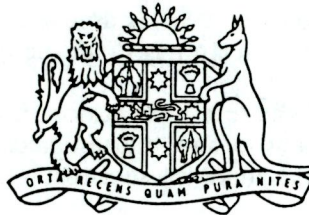
