



- 2. (1) Sections 1 and 2 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.
- (2) Except as provided by subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2(2) of the Landlord and Tenant (Rental Bonds) Amendment Act, 1985.




