CONVEYANCING (SOLICITORS' REMUNERATION) AMENDMENT BILL, 1984

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Legal Practitioners (Solicitors' Remuneration) Amendment Bill, 1984.

The object of this Bill is to repeal the provisions of the Conveyancing Act, 1919, relating to solicitors' remuneration. Provisions with respect to solicitors' remuneration are to be inserted into the Legal Practitioners Act, 1898, by the proposed Legal Practitioners (Solicitors' Remuneration) Amendment Act, 1984.

Conveyancing (Solicitors' Remuneration) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Conveyancing (Solicitors' Remuneration) Amendment Act, 1984".

Commencement.

2. (1) Sections 1 and 2 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.

10 (2) Except as provided by subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Legal Practitioners (Solicitors' Remuneration) Amendment Act, 1984.

Amendment of Act No. 6, 1919.

3. The Conveyancing Act, 1919, is amended by omitting Part XXIV 15 and the matter relating to that Part in section 2.

Conveyancing (Solicitors' Remuneration) Amendment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Conveyancing (Solicitors' Remuneration) Amendment Act, 1984".

Commencement.

2. (1) Sections 1 and 2 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Except as provided by subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Legal Practitioners (Solicitors' Remuneration) Amendment Act, 1984.

Amendment of Act No. 6, 1919.

3. The Conveyancing Act, 1919, is amended by omitting Part XXIV and the matter relating to that Part in section 2.
