

**CRIMES (SUMMARY PROCEDURE) AMENDMENT BILL
1985**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Justices (Penalties and Procedure) Amendment Bill 1985.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Crimes Act 1900 so as to repeal section 476 (8) of that Act.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the proposed Act.

Clause 3 repeals section 476 (8) of the Principal Act because the effect of that subsection will be implemented by proposed section 51B of the Justices Act 1902, intended to be inserted in that Act by the proposed Justices (Penalties and Procedure) Amendment Act 1985. Section 476 (8) of the Principal Act provided that, where a person consented to an indictable offence being dealt with summarily and the person was convicted of the offence and fined, the provisions of section 82 of the Justices Act 1902 requiring the terms of the conviction to provide for imprisonment in the event of failure to pay the fine are applicable.

Crimes (Summary Procedure) Amendment 1985

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

5 Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the "Crimes (Summary Procedure) Amendment Act 1985".

Commencement

2. (1) Except as provided by subsection (2), this Act shall commence
10 on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Section 3 shall commence on the date of assent to the Justices (Penalties and Procedure) Amendment Act 1985.

Amendment of Act No. 40, 1900

3. The Crimes Act 1900 is amended by omitting section 476 (8).
