


This Bill is cognate with the Conveyancing (Forestry Rights) Amendment Bill 1987.


The object of this Bill is to amend section 11 of the Forestry Act 1916 so as to enable the Forestry Commission to enter into agreements under which the Commission carries out sylvicultural activities on private land.


Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides that the proposed Act will commence on the commencement of the proposed Conveyancing (Forestry Rights) Amendment Act 1987.

Clause 3 amends section 11 of the Principal Act so as to give effect to the object referred to above.

## A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section 11 of the Forestry Act 1916 so as to enable the Forestry Commission to enter into certain sylvicultural agreements.

### The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

### Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Forestry (Forestry Rights) Amendment Act 1987.

### 5 Commencement

2. This Act shall commence on the commencement of the Conveyancing (Forestry Rights) Amendment Act 1987.

### Amendment of Act No. 55, 1916

- 3. The Forestry Act 1916 is amended by inserting after section 11 (1) (m) 10 (ii) the following subparagraph:
  - (iia) under which the commission carries out sylvicultural activities on, or under which the commission obtains the benefit of a forestry right (within the meaning of Division 4 of Part VI of the Conveyancing Act 1919) in respect of, that person's land;



## Act No. 244, 1987

An Act to amend section 11 of the Forestry Act 1916 so as to enable the Forestry Commission to enter into certain sylvicultural agreements. [Assented to 16 December 1987]

### The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

### Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Forestry (Forestry Rights) Amendment Act 1987.

#### Commencement

2. This Act shall commence on the commencement of the Conveyancing (Forestry Rights) Amendment Act 1987.

### Amendment of Act No. 55, 1916

- 3. The Forestry Act 1916 is amended by inserting after section 11 (1) (m) (ii) the following subparagraph:
  - (iia) under which the commission carries out sylvicultural activities on, or under which the commission obtains the benefit of a forestry right (within the meaning of Division 4 of Part VI of the Conveyancing Act 1919) in respect of, that person's land;
