EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

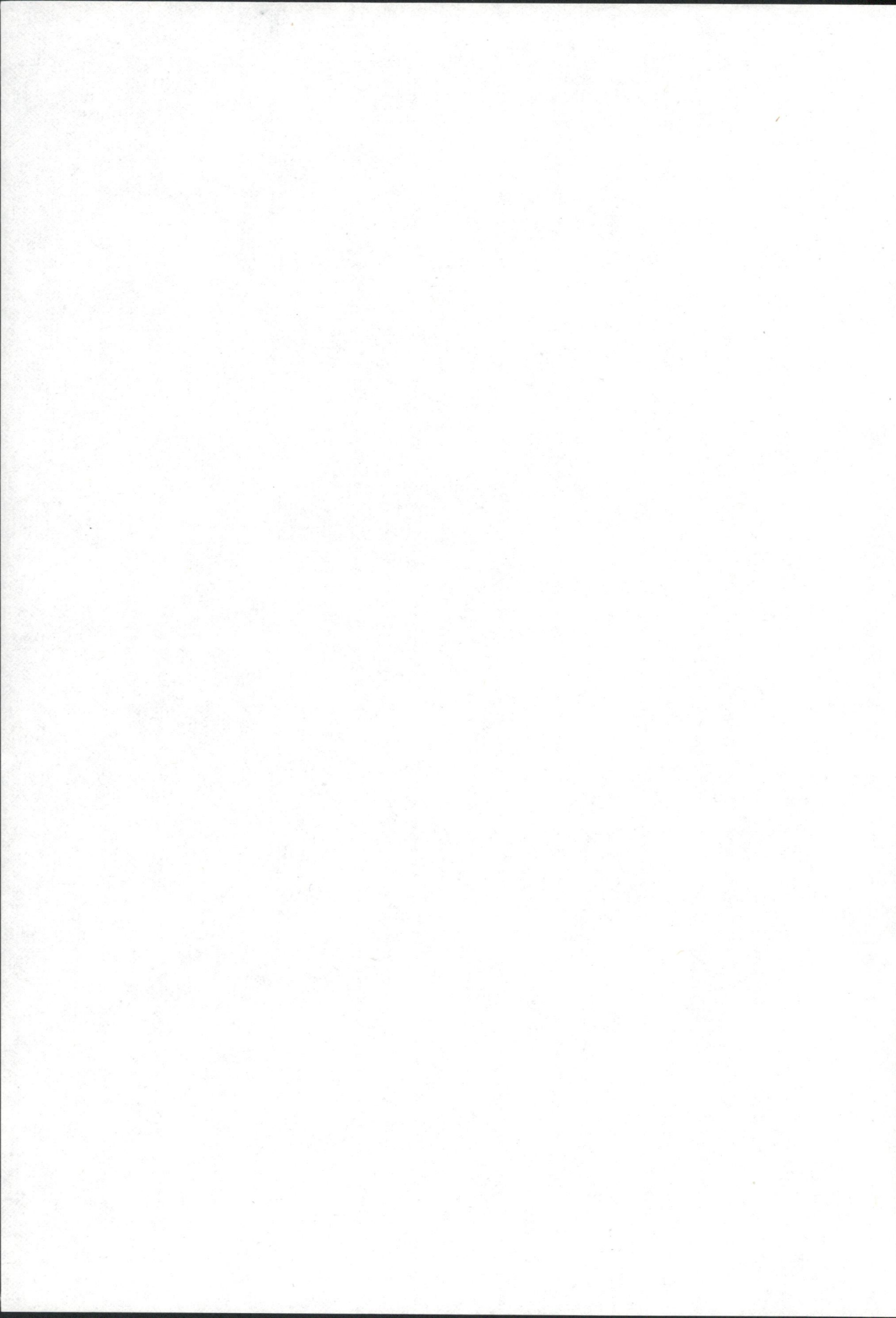
This Bill is cognate with the Registered Clubs (Entertainment) Amendment Bill 1986.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Local Government Act 1919 consequent on the enactment of the proposed Registered Clubs (Entertainment) Amendment Act 1986.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides that the proposed Act will, with minor exceptions, commence on the day on which Schedule 1 (6) to the proposed Registered Clubs (Entertainment) Amendment Act 1986 commences.

Clause 3 inserts proposed section 317JC into the Principal Act to provide that if a council gives a fire safety order in relation to licensed premises under the Liquor Act 1982 or the premises of a registered club, within the meaning of the Registered Clubs Act 1976, a person affected by the order may object to the Liquor Administration Board.



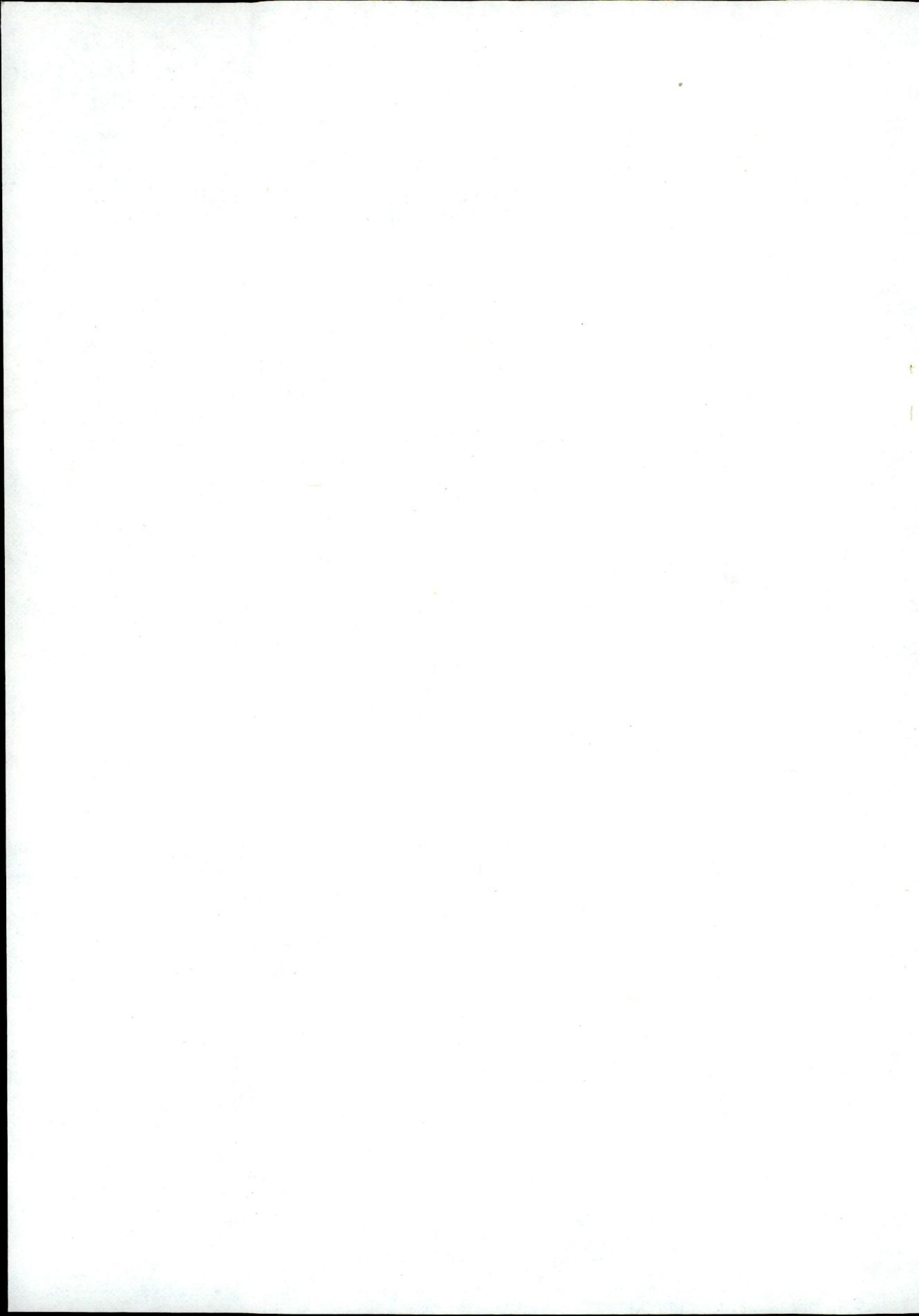

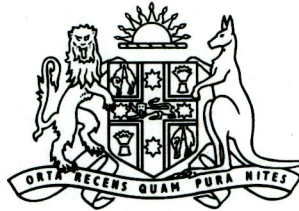

A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the Local Government Act 1919 consequent on the enactment of the Registered Clubs (Entertainment) Amendment Act 1986.

Local Government (Registered Clubs) Amendment 1986

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

5 Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the "Local Government (Registered Clubs) Amendment Act 1986".

Commencement

2. (1) Sections 1 and 2 shall commence on the date of assent to this
10 Act.

(2) Except as provided by subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day on which Schedule 1 (6) to the Registered Clubs (Entertainment) Amendment Act 1986 commences.

Amendment of Act No. 41, 1919

15 3. The Local Government Act 1919 is amended by inserting after section 317JB the following section:

Premises licensed under the Liquor Act 1982 or registered under the Registered Clubs Act 1976

20 317JC. If a council makes an order under section 317D in relation to premises licensed under the Liquor Act 1982 or the premises of a registered club within the meaning of the Registered Clubs Act 1976, this Division (sections 317JA and 317JB excepted) applies to and in respect of the order as if the references in sections
25 317C, 317F and 317G to the Land and Environment Court or the Court were references to the Liquor Administration Board within the meaning of the Liquor Act 1982.
