

**MISCELLANEOUS ACTS (WORKERS' COMPENSATION)
AMENDMENT BILL, 1985**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Workers' Compensation (Amendment) Bill, 1985.

The object of this Bill is to amend certain Acts as a consequence of, and in connection with, the proposed enactment of the Workers' Compensation (Amendment) Act, 1985, and the Compensation Court (Amendment) Act, 1985.

Miscellaneous Acts (Workers' Compensation) Amendment 1985

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Miscellaneous Acts (Workers' Compensation) Amendment Act, 1985".

Commencement.

2. (1) Except as provided by subsections (2) and (3), this Act shall
10 commence on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) The several provisions of Schedule 1 (item (1) of the matter relating to the Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration Act, 1975, excepted) shall commence on such day or days as may be appointed by the Governor in respect thereof and as may be notified by proclamation published in the
15 Gazette.

(3) Section 3, in its application to a provision of Schedule 1, shall commence on the day on which the provision commences.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
