### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

### (This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The object of this Bill is to repeal the New South Wales Government Engineering and Shipbuilding Undertaking Act 1943, under which the State Dockyard was established.


Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 (1) repeals the enactments mentioned in Schedule 1 to the proposed Act.

Clause 2 (2) contains the usual provisions relating to the abolition of statutory bodies: the subclause removes the Directors of the State Dockyard Board from office and declares that no compensation is payable.

Schedule 1 lists the enactments to be repealed.

## A BILL FOR

An Act to repeal the New South Wales Government Engineering and Shipbuilding Undertaking Act 1943 and for associated purposes.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

### 5 Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the "New South Wales Government Engineering and Shipbuilding Undertaking (Repeal) Act 1987".

#### Repeals

2. (1) Each Act specified in Schedule 1 is, to the extent indicated, 10 repealed.

(2) A person who, immediately before the commencement of this Act. held office as a Director of the State Dockvard Board of New South Wales-

(a) shall cease to hold office as such on that commencement; and

(b) is not entitled to be paid any remuneration or compensation by reason of so ceasing to hold that office.





## Act No. 24, 1987

An Act to repeal the New South Wales Government Engineering and Shipbuilding Undertaking Act 1943 and for associated purposes. [Assented to 5 May 1987]

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

#### Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the "New South Wales Government Engineering and Shipbuilding Undertaking (Repeal) Act 1987".

### Repeals

2. (1) Each Act specified in Schedule 1 is, to the extent indicated, repealed.

(2) A person who, immediately before the commencement of this Act, held office as a Director of the State Dockyard Board of New South Wales—

- (a) shall cease to hold office as such on that commencement; and
