EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The object of this Bill is to amend the New South Wales Investment Corporation Act 1986 to increase the maximum number of directors of the New South Wales Investment Corporation from 8 to 10. The 2 additional directors will be part-time directors.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 amends the Principal Act to effect the amendment referred to above.

5 Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the "New South Wales Investment Corporation (Amendment) Act 1986".


