**NEW SOUTH WALES STATE CANCER COUNCIL
(AMENDMENT) BILL, 1984**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The object of this Bill is to enable the New South Wales State Cancer Council ("the Council") to employ staff of any category. At present medical, scientific and technical staff may be employed by the Council, but other staff is required to be employed under the Public Service Act, 1979.

A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the New South Wales State Cancer Council Act, 1955,
with respect to the staff employed under that Act.

New South Wales State Cancer Council (Amendment) 1984

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "New South Wales State Cancer Council (Amendment) Act, 1984".

Amendment of Act No. 25, 1955.

2. The New South Wales State Cancer Council Act, 1955, is amended 10 by omitting section 15 and by inserting instead the following section:—

Staff of Council.

15 15. (1) The Council may employ such staff as may be necessary to enable the Council to exercise and discharge its powers, authorities, duties and functions.

 (2) The Public Service Act, 1979, does not apply to or in respect of the employment of staff under subsection (1) and a person is not, as a member of that staff, subject to that Act.

 (3) The remuneration (including travelling and subsistence allowances) payable to staff employed under subsection (1) shall be 20 part of the costs of administration of this Act.

 (4) For the purpose of enabling the Council to exercise and discharge its powers, authorities, duties and functions, the Council may—

 (a) with the approval of the Minister administering a government 25 department or an administrative office; and

(b) on such terms and conditions as may be approved by the Public Service Board,

arrange for the use of the services of any staff or facilities of the department or office, as the case may be.

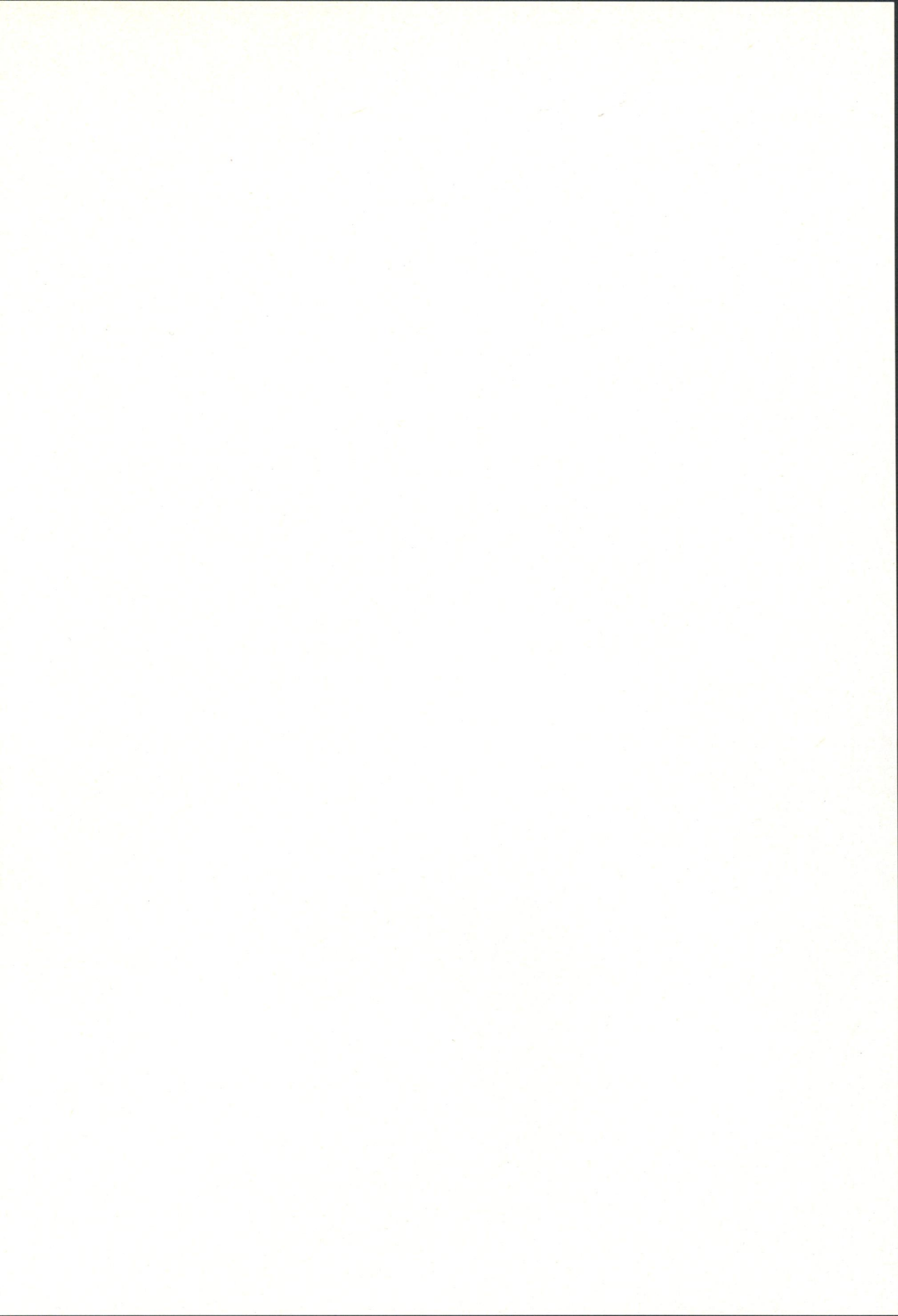
5 Provision relating to existing staff.

Act No. 137, 1984.

An Act to amend the New South Wales State Cancer Council Act, 1955, with respect to the staff employed under that Act. [Assented to, 4th December, 1984.]

New South Wales State Cancer Council (Amendment) 1984

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "New South Wales State Cancer Council (Amendment) Act, 1984".

Amendment of Act No. 25, 1955.

2. The New South Wales State Cancer Council Act, 1955, is amended by omitting section 15 and by inserting instead the following section:—

Staff of Council.

15. (1) The Council may employ such staff as may be necessary to enable the Council to exercise and discharge its powers, authorities, duties and functions.

(2) The Public Service Act, 1979, does not apply to or in respect of the employment of staff under subsection (1) and a person is not, as a member of that staff, subject to that Act.

(3) The remuneration (including travelling and subsistence allowances) payable to staff employed under subsection (1) shall be part of the costs of administration of this Act.

(4) For the purpose of enabling the Council to exercise and discharge its powers, authorities, duties and functions, the Council may—

(a) with the approval of the Minister administering a government department or an administrative office; and

(b) on such terms and conditions as may be approved by the Public Service Board,

arrange for the use of the services of any staff or facilities of the department or office, as the case may be.

Provision relating to existing staff.

3. Persons (other than public servants) employed by the New South Wales State Cancer Council immediately before the commencement of this Act (whether or not employed in accordance with the New South Wales State Cancer Council Act, 1955) shall, on and from that commencement, be deemed to have been employed by that Council under section 15 of that Act, as amended by this Act.
