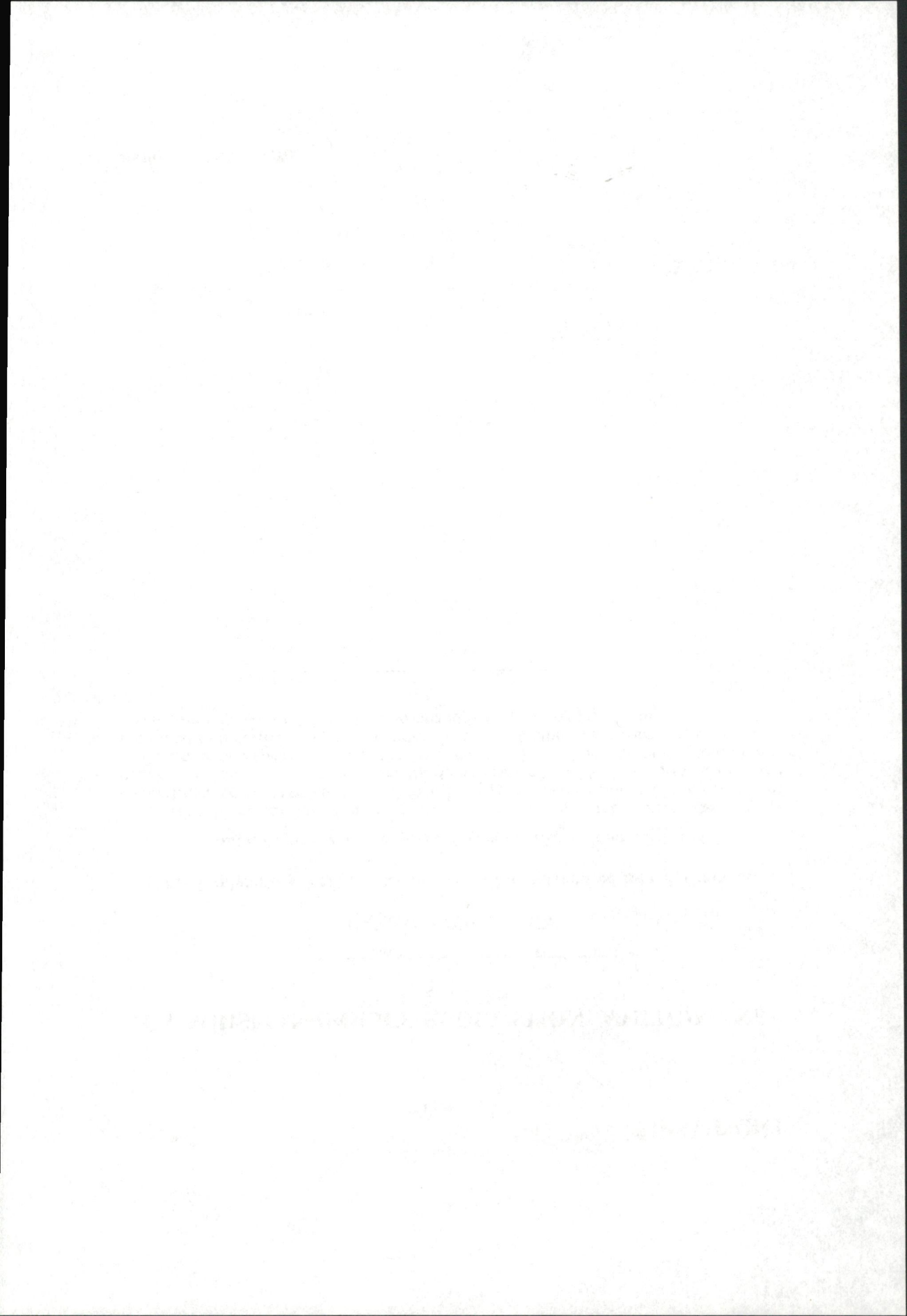
**OMBUDSMAN (POLICE REGULATION) AMENDMENT
BILL 1985**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Police Regulation (Amendment) Bill 1985.

The object of this Bill is to authorise an acting Ombudsman, the Deputy Ombudsman or an Assistant Ombudsman to carry out investigations of the conduct of members of the Police Force under the Ombudsman Act 1974. At present only the Ombudsman or a special officer of the Ombudsman who is a member of the Police Force is entitled to investigate any such conduct where the Ombudsman considers that further investigation is required. The Bill also includes a validating provision.

A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the Ombudsman Act 1974 to enable an acting Ombudsman, the Deputy Ombudsman or an Assistant Ombudsman to investigate the conduct of a member of the Police Force.

Ombudsman (Police Regulation) Amendment 1985

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

5 Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the "Ombudsman (Police Regulation) Amendment Act 1985".

Amendment of Act No. 68, 1974

2. The Ombudsman Act 1974 is amended in the manner set forth in 10 Schedule 1.

Validation

3. All things done or omitted to be done at any time before the commencement of this Act that would have been valid had the amendments made by this Act been in force at that time are validated.

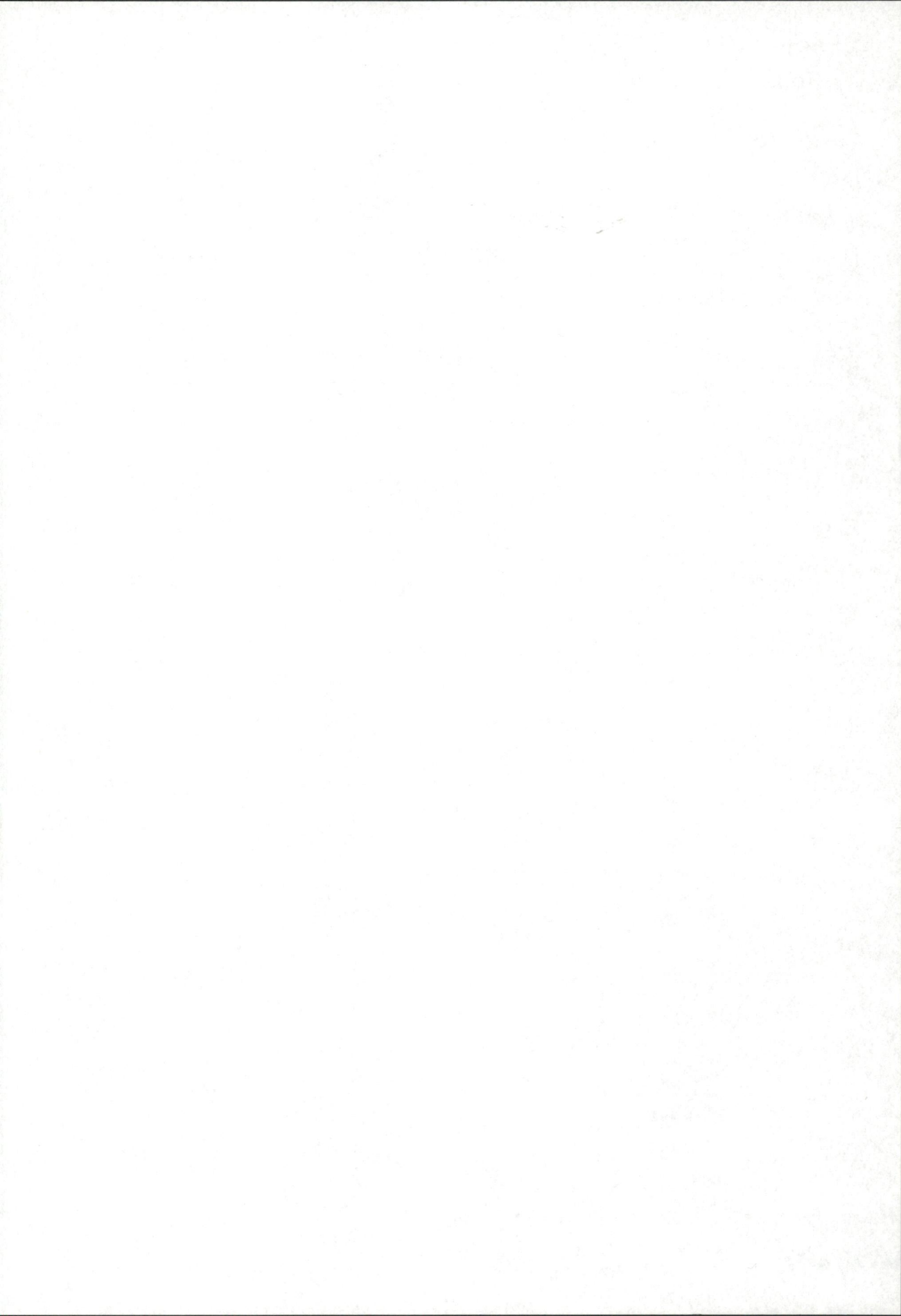

Act No. 213, 1985

An Act to amend the Ombudsman Act 1974 to enable an acting Ombudsman, the Deputy Ombudsman or an Assistant Ombudsman to investigate the conduct of a member of the Police Force. [Assented to, 10th December, 1985.]

Ombudsman (Police Regulation) Amendment 1985

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the "Ombudsman (Police Regulation) Amendment Act 1985".
