


EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Superannuation Administration Bill 1987.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Police Association Employees (Superannuation) Act 1969 to extend to employees of the Police Association who remain contributors to the Police Superannuation Fund the improved benefits proposed for serving members of the police force who are contributors to that Fund. The improved benefits are contained in the Police Regulation (Superannuation) Amendment Bill 1987. The Bill also repeals a provision relating to appeals which is being transferred to the proposed Superannuation Act 1987.

A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the Police Association Employees (Superannuation) Act 1969 as a consequence of the enactment of the Police Regulation (Superannuation) Amendment Act 1987.

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Police Association Employees (Superannuation) Amendment Act 1987.

5 Commencement

2. This Act shall commence on a day or days to be appointed by proclamation.

3. The Police Association Employees (Superannuation) Act 1969 is 10 amended as set out in Schedule 1.




