### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

**(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)**

This Bill is cognate with the Police Regulation (Promotions) Amendment Bill, 1984.

The object of this Bill is to require the Officer-in-Charge of the Internal Affairs Branch of the police force, upon being required by the Minister, the Police Board or the Commissioner so to do, to submit a report upon a person being considered for appointment to the rank of inspector or any higher rank.

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**5 Short title.**

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "Police Regulation (Allegations of Misconduct) Amendment Act, 1984".

**Commencement.**

**2. (1)** Sections 1 and 2 shall commence on the date of assent to this

**(2)** Except as provided by subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Police Regulation (Promotions) Amendment Act, 1984.
