PRISONS (REMISSIONS) AMENDMENT BILL 1986

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

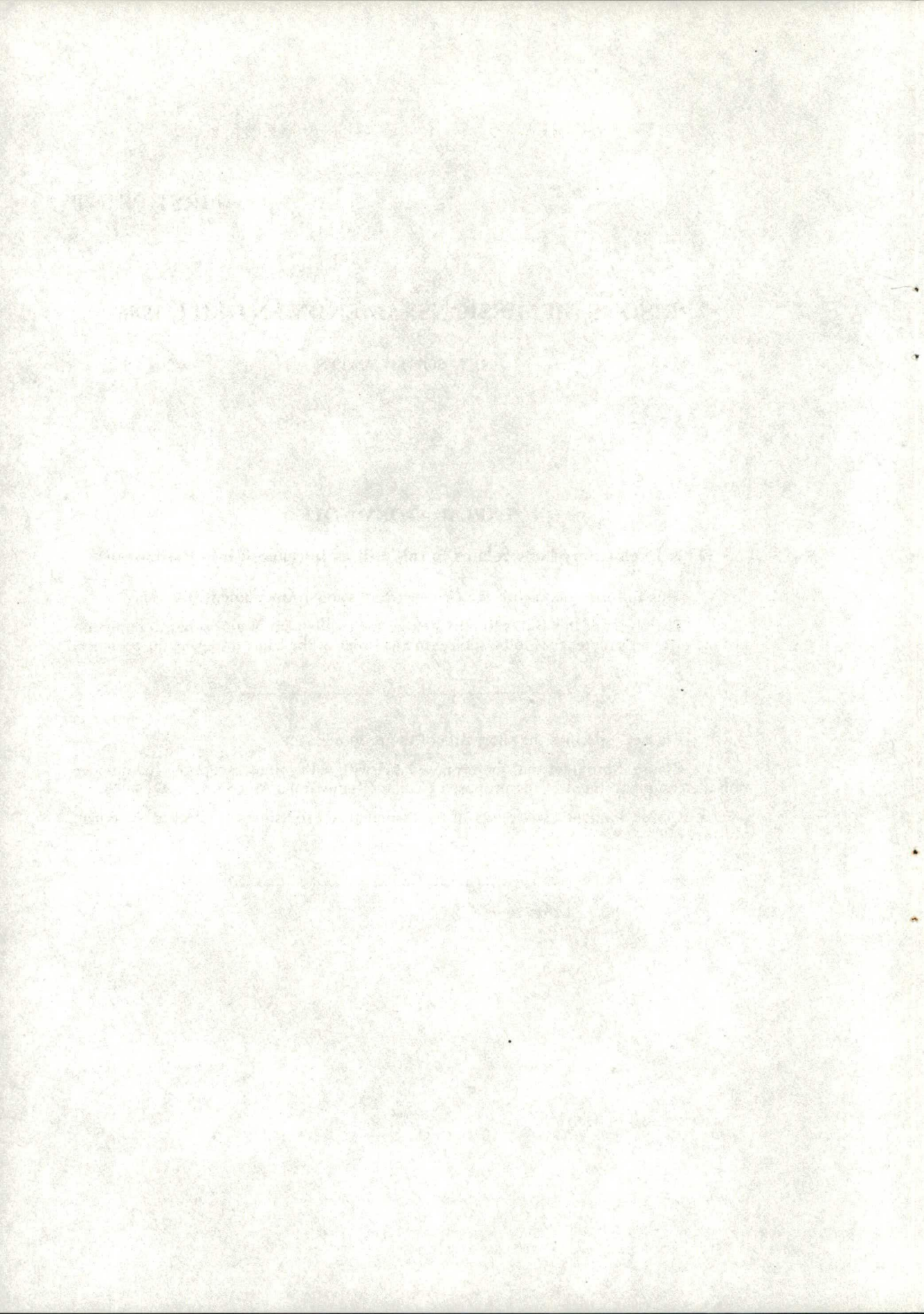
This Bill is cognate with the Crimes (Remissions) Amendment Bill 1986.

The object of this Bill is to provide that the entitlement of a prisoner to remission of the prisoner's sentence is to be subject to any order of the court imposing the sentence.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides that the proposed Act will, with minor exceptions, commence on the commencement of the proposed Crimes (Remissions) Amendment Act 1986.

Clause 3 amends section 41 of the Principal Act so as to give effect to the object of this Bill.



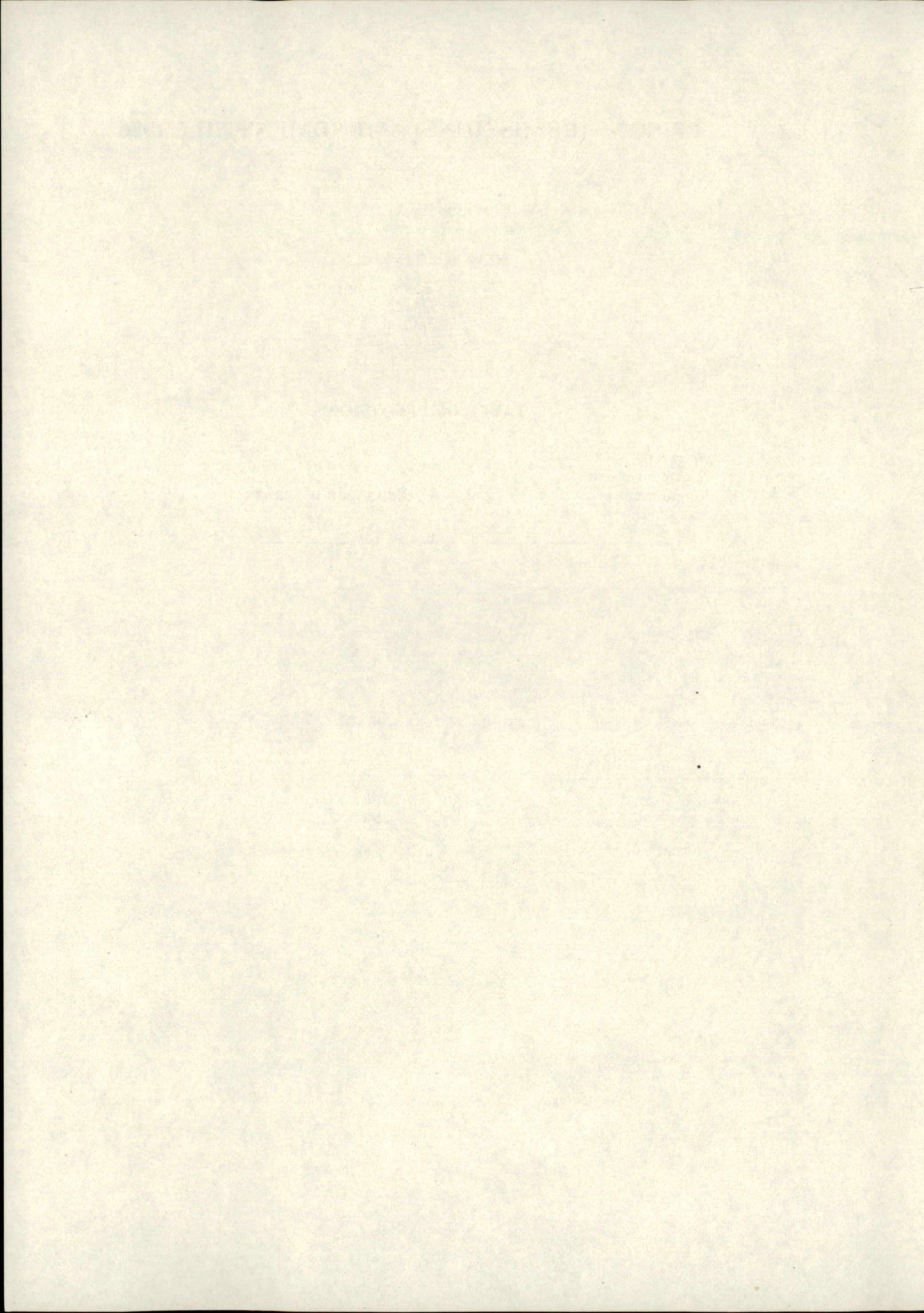

An Act to amend section 41 of the Prisons Act 1952 with respect to the granting of remissions of prisoners' sentences.

Prisons (Remissions) Amendment 1986

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

5 Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the "Prisons (Remissions) Amendment Act 1986":

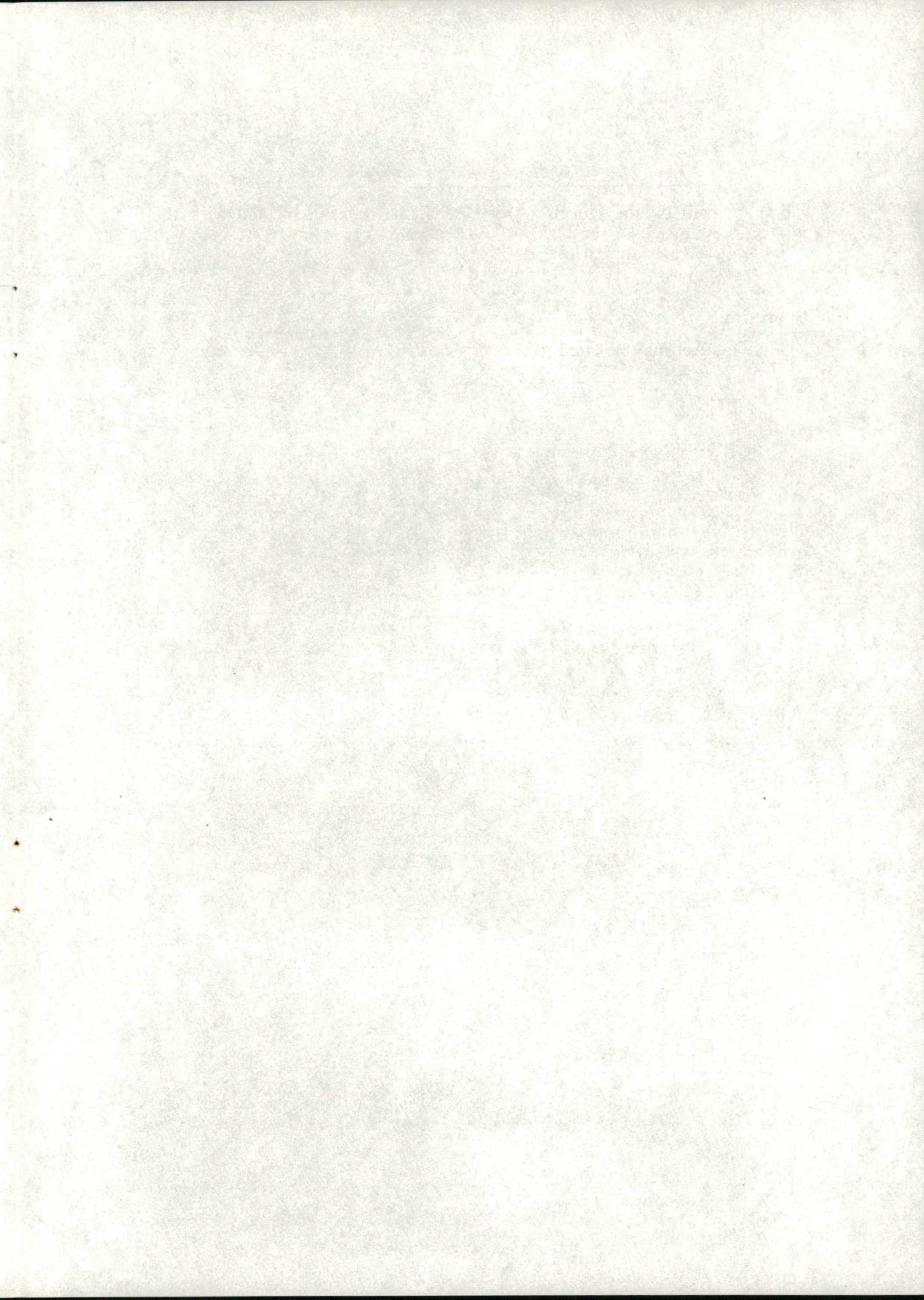
Commencement

2. (1) Sections 1 and 2 shall commence on the date of assent to this

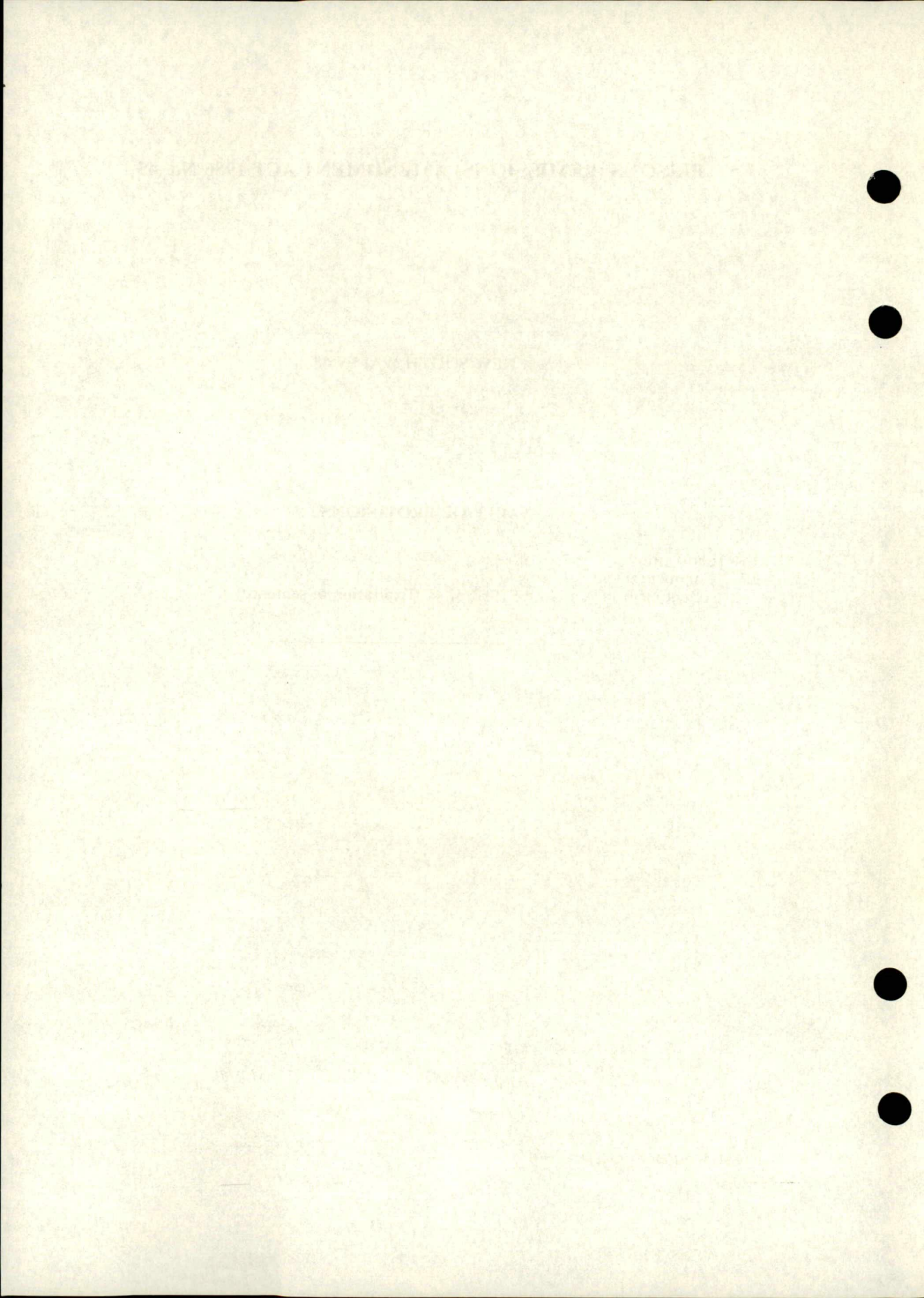

Prisons (Remissions) Amendment 1986
