EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Necropolis (Amendment) Bill 1986.


The object of this Bill is to provide that the provision of the Principal Act which requires the operator of a crematorium in a cemetery to contribute towards the upkeep of the cemetery does not apply to the crematorium within the Necropolis at Rookwood.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides that the proposed Act will, with minor exceptions, commence on the commencement of the relevant provisions of the proposed Necropolis (Amendment) Act 1986.

Clause 3 amends section 51c of the Public Health Act 1902 to provide that the section does not apply to the crematorium within the Necropolis at Rookwood. The section requires a person conducting a crematorium within a cemetery to contribute to the upkeep of the cemetery. Provision for a similar contribution by the operator of the Rookwood crematorium will be inserted in the Necropolis Act 1901 by the proposed Necropolis (Amendment) Act 1986.

An Act to amend the Public Health Act 1902 with respect to the charges payable by the operator of the crematorium within the Necropolis.

Public Health (Necropolis) Amendment 1986

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

5 Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the "Public Health (Necropolis) Amendment Act 1986".

Commencement

2. (1) Sections 1 and 2 shall commence on the date of assent to this 10 Act.


(2) Except as provided by subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the commencement of Schedule 2 to the Necropolis (Amendment) Act 1986.

An Act to amend the Public Health Act 1902 with respect to the charges payable by the operator of the crematorium within the Necropolis. [Assented to 17 December 1986]

Public Health (Necropolis) Amendment 1986

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the "Public Health (Necropolis) Amendment Act 1986".

Commencement

(2) Except as provided by subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the commencement of Schedule 2 to the Necropolis (Amendment) Act 1986.
