Act No. 1, 1986

An Act to amend the Standard Time Act 1971 in its application to the period of summer time ending in 1986. [Assented to 27 February 1986.]

Standard Time (Amendment) 1986

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the "Standard Time (Amendment) Act 1986".

Extension of summer time in 1986

2. Section 5 of the Standard Time Act 1971 applies to and in respect of the period that commenced at 2.00 a.m. on Sunday 27 October 1985 as if the reference in subsection (1) of that section to the first Sunday in the month of March were a reference to 16 March 1986.

STANDARD TIME (AMENDMENT) BILL 1986

THE Bill introduced by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in the House of Commons in the first session of the 10th Parliament of the United Kingdom in the 31st year of Her Majesty's most Excellent Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second, by Her Majesty's Command, and by the authority of the House of Commons, and by the authority of the House of Lords, is as follows:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The object of this Bill is to extend the current period of daylight saving by two weeks to Sunday 16 March 1986 (instead of 2 March 1986).

STANDARD TIME (AMENDMENT) BILL 1986

1. The Standard Time Act, 1956, shall be amended in the manner hereinafter provided, that is to say—

(a) in section 2, the definition of "Standard Time" shall be amended so as to read—

(b) in section 3, the definition of "Standard Time" shall be amended so as to read—

"Standard Time" means the time which is determined by the Government of India in accordance with the provisions of this Act;
