EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The object of this Bill is to extend the next period of daylight saving by one week at its beginning and two weeks at its end.

The period will therefore start on Sunday 19 October 1986 and end on Sunday 15 March 1987 (instead of 26 October and 1 March respectively).




5 Short title

- 2. Section 5 of the Standard Time Act 1971 applies to and in respect 10 of the period from October 1986 to March 1987 as if the reference in subsection (1) of that section to—
 - (a) the last Sunday in the month of October were a reference to Sunday 19 October 1986; and
- (b) the first Sunday in the month of March were a reference to Sunday 15 March 1987.






