An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Fund and the Road Transport and Traffic Fund towards the services of the Year 1985-1986.

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

#### 5 Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the "Supply Act 1985".

# \$1,110,113,000 may be issued out of the Consolidated Fund for recurrent services

2. Out of the Consolidated Fund there is hereby appropriated and may 10 be issued and applied the sum of \$1,110,113,000 to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of October and November of the financial year ending 30 June 1986, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of that year.

3. Out of the Consolidated Fund there is hereby appropriated and may be issued and applied the sum of \$81,511,000 to meet the capital works and services expenditure of the various Departments and Services of the State

# \$30,117,000 may be issued out of the Road Transport and Traffic Fund for certain expenses

Out of the Road Transport and Traffic Fund there is hereby appropriated and may be issued and applied the sum of \$30,117,000 to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses specified in section 202 (2) of the Transport Act 1930 during the months of October and November of the financial year ending 30 June 1986, subject
- 30 to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of that year.


### Treasurer's authority to pay sums appropriated

interest to provide for expenditure for the purposes referred to in sections 2, 3 and 4.


### Treasurer to have credit and receipts to discharge Treasurer


