SYDNEY OPERA HOUSE (AMENDMENT) BILL 1985

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Bennelong Point (Parking Station) Bill 1985.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Sydney Opera House Act 1960 to delete the provision previously made for the construction of a parking station near the Sydney Opera House in conjunction with the Australian Mutual Provident Society. Provision for the construction of a parking station on the site is to be made by the proposed Bennelong Point (Parking Station) Act 1985.

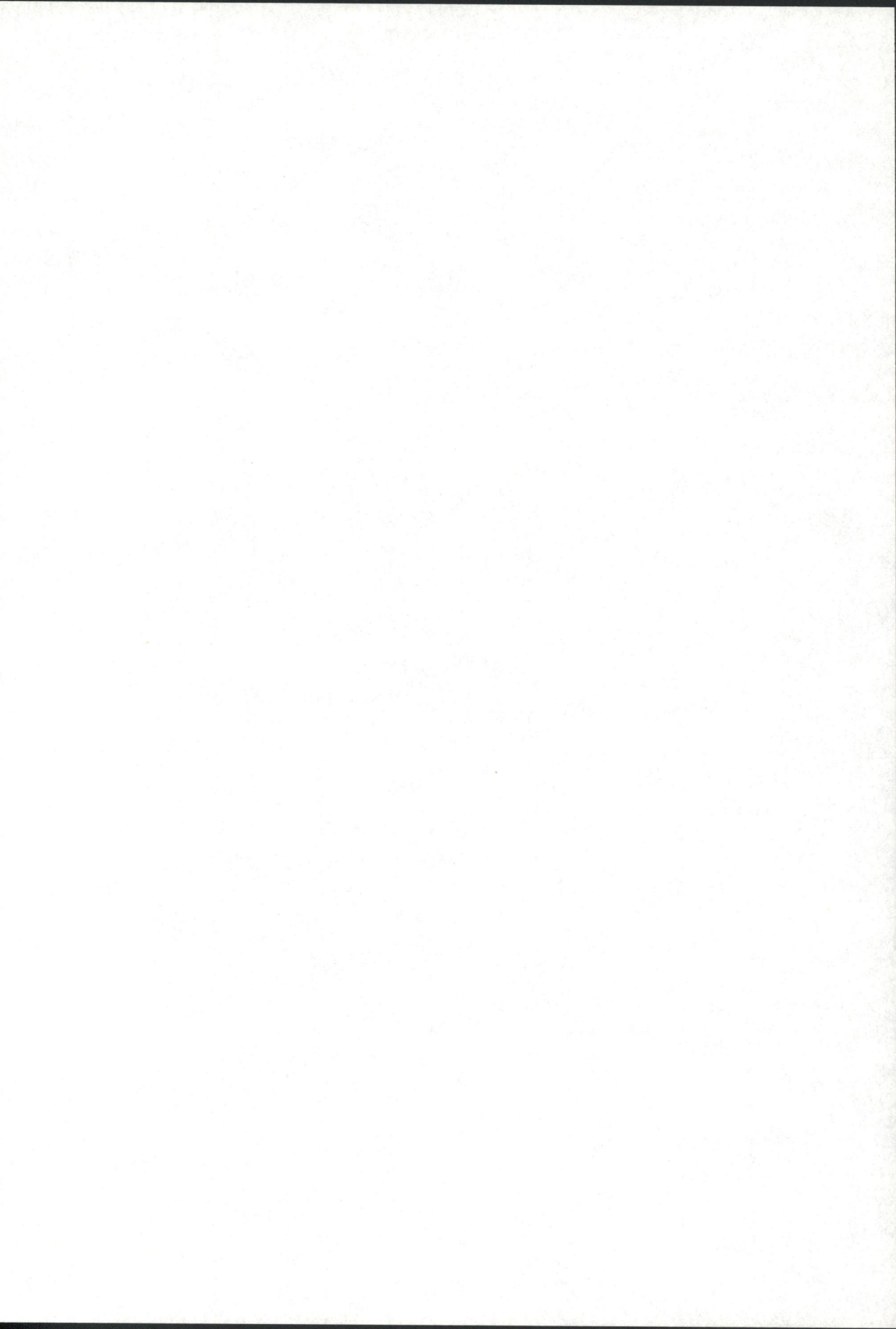
