The object of this Bill is to repeal Part IIIA (Censorship of Films) of the Theatres and Public Halls Act, 1908, as a consequence of the enactment of similar provisions in the proposed Film and Video Tape Classification Act, 1984.

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**5 Short title.**

1. This Act may be cited as the "Theatres and Public Halls (Film and Video Tape Classification) Amendment Act, 1984".

**Commencement.**

2. (1) Sections 1 and 2 shall commence on the date of assent to this  
10 Act.

(2) Except as provided by subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 (2) of the Film and Video Tape Classification Act, 1984.


