**TOTALIZATOR (OFF-COURSE BETTING) AMENDMENT
BILL, 1985**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The object of this Bill is to amend the Totalizator (Off-course Betting) Act, 1964, so as to allow the Totalizator Agency Board to use facilities or services that are not fully utilised in its betting operations for other commercial undertakings (Schedule 1).

A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the Totalizator (Off-course Betting) Act, 1964, to allow the Totalizator Agency Board to carry out certain commercial undertakings.

Totalizator (Off-course Betting) Amendment 1985

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Totalizator (Off-course Betting) Amendment Act, 1985".

Amendment of Act No. 1, 1964.

2. The Totalizator (Off-course Betting) Act, 1964, is amended in the 10 manner set forth in Schedule 1.

(1) Section 16B—

15 After section 16A, insert:—

Ancillary commercial undertakings by the Board.

16B. (1) The Board may, with the approval of the Governor, use facilities or services that are not fully utilised in its betting operations for commercial undertakings.

20 (2) The Board may, for the purpose of a commercial undertaking under subsection (1), act as an agent for a public or local authority, corporation or other body.

(4) Nothing in this section restricts any power, authority, duty or function that the Board has as an approved representative under section 10 (4) of the Soccer Football Pools Act, 1975, or that the Board has under this or any other Act (apart from this section).

(5) The Board may, for the purpose of a commercial undertaking under subsection (1), do all things not expressly authorised by this Act that are necessary or convenient for, or incidental to, that purpose.

(2) Section 17A—

Omit "in connection with its betting operations".

In the name and on behalf of Her Majesty I assent to this Act.
