TRADE UNION (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1985

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The Industrial Arbitration (Trade Union) Amendment Bill, 1985, is cognate with this Bill.

The object of this Bill is to enable the annual general statement of accounts of a trade union registered under the Trade Union Act 1881 which is required to be transmitted to the Industrial Registrar to be prepared in respect of each financial year of the trade union instead of each calendar year.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Trade Union (Amendment) Act, 1985".



An Act to amend the Trade Union Act 1881 in relation to the annual general statement of accounts of trade unions. [Assented to, 10th April, 1985.]

Trade Union (Amendment) 1985

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Trade Union (Amendment) Act, 1985".
