
EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament) The object of this Bill is to amend the Constitution Act 1902 to authorise Members of the Legislative Council to be called Senators.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the proposed Act to commence on the date of assent.

Clause 3 amends the Constitution Act 1902 for the above purposes.



A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the Constitution Act 1902 to authorise Members of the Legislative Council to be called Senators.

Constitution (Senators) Amendment 1991

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Constitution (Senators) Amendment Act 1991.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the date of assent.

Amendment of Constitution Act 1902 No. 32

3. The Constitution Act 1902 is amended by inserting after Division 3 of Part 3 the following Division:

Division 4—Miscellaneous

Senators

34A. A Member of the Legislative Council may also be called a Senator.
