**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

**(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)**

The object of this Bill is to amend the Constitution Act 1902 to authorise Members of the Legislative Council to be called Senators.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the proposed Act to commence on the date of assent.

Clause 3 amends the Constitution Act 1902 for the above purposes.

**The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:**

**Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the Constitution (Senators) Amendment Act 1991.

**Commencement**

2. This Act commences on the date of assent.

**Amendment of Constitution Act 1902 No. 32**

3. The Constitution Act 1902 is amended by inserting after Division 3 of Part 3 the following Division:

**Division 4—Miscellaneous**

**Senators**

34A. A Member of the Legislative Council may also be called a Senator.
