

An Act to amend the Inclosed Lands Protection Act 1901 in relation to penalties for offences against that Act. [Assented to 21 December 1989]

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Inclosed Lands Protection (Amendment) Act 1989.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on a day or days to be appointed by proclamation.

Amendment of Inclosed Lands Protection Act 1901 No. 33

3. The Inclosed Lands Protection Act 1901 is amended as set out in Schedule 1.

- (2) Section 4A (Offensive conduct while upon inclosed lands): From section 4A (1), omit "\$500", insert instead "\$1,000".
- (3) Section 5 (Penalty on leaving gate open):
 Omit "\$100" wherever occurring, insert instead "\$200".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Crimes (Amendment) Bill 1989.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Inclosed Lands Protection Act 1901, so as to increase certain penalties.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the proposed Act to commence by proclamation.


Clause 3 is a formal provision giving effect to the Schedule of amendments.

SCHEDULE 1 - AMENDMENTS

Schedule 1 (1) increases the penalty for unlawful entry on inclosed lands.

Schedule 1 (2) increases the penalty for offensive conduct while on inclosed lands.

Schedule 1 (3) increases the penalty for leaving certain gates open.


