**The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:**

**Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the Inclosed Lands Protection (Amendment) Act 1989.

**Commencement**

2. This Act commences on a day or days to be appointed by proclamation.

3. The Inclosed Lands Protection Act 1901 is amended as set out in Schedule 1.

**SCHEDULE 1 - AMENDMENTS**

(Sec. 3)

(1) Section 4 (**Penalty for unlawful entry upon inclosed lands**):

From section 4 (1), omit "\$100", insert instead "\$500".

(2) Section 4A (**Offensive conduct while upon inclosed lands**):

From section 4A (1), omit "\$500", insert instead "\$1,000".

(3) Section 5 (**Penalty on leaving gate open**):

Omit "\$100" wherever occurring, insert instead "\$200".

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

**(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)**

This Bill is cognate with the Crimes (Amendment) Bill 1989.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Inclosed Lands Protection Act 1901, so as to increase certain penalties.

---

**Clause 1** specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

**Clause 2** provides for the proposed Act to commence by proclamation.

**Clause 3** is a formal provision giving effect to the Schedule of amendments.

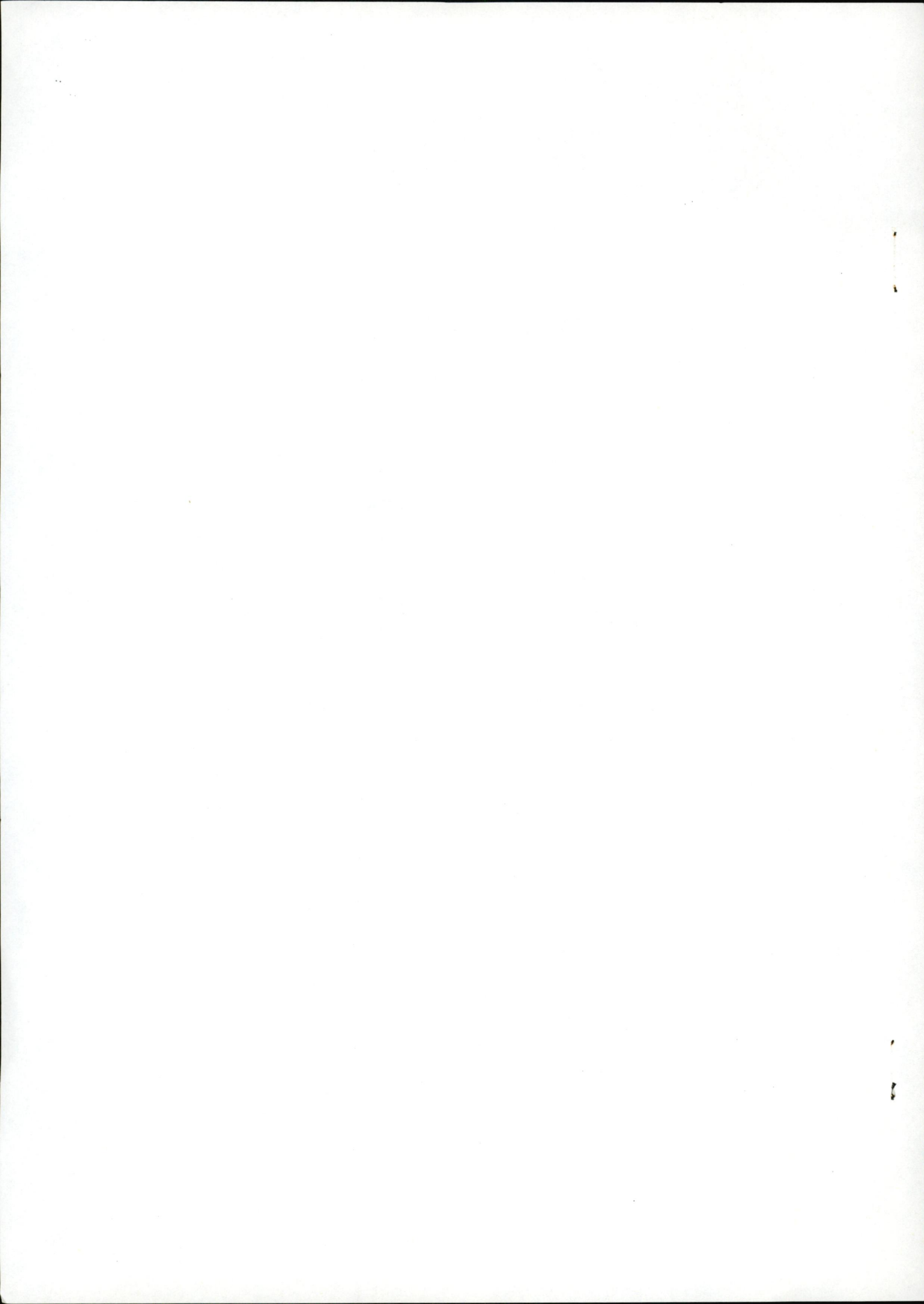
**SCHEDULE 1 - AMENDMENTS**

**Schedule 1 (1)** increases the penalty for unlawful entry on inclosed lands.

**Schedule 1 (2)** increases the penalty for offensive conduct while on inclosed lands.

**Schedule 1 (3)** increases the penalty for leaving certain gates open.

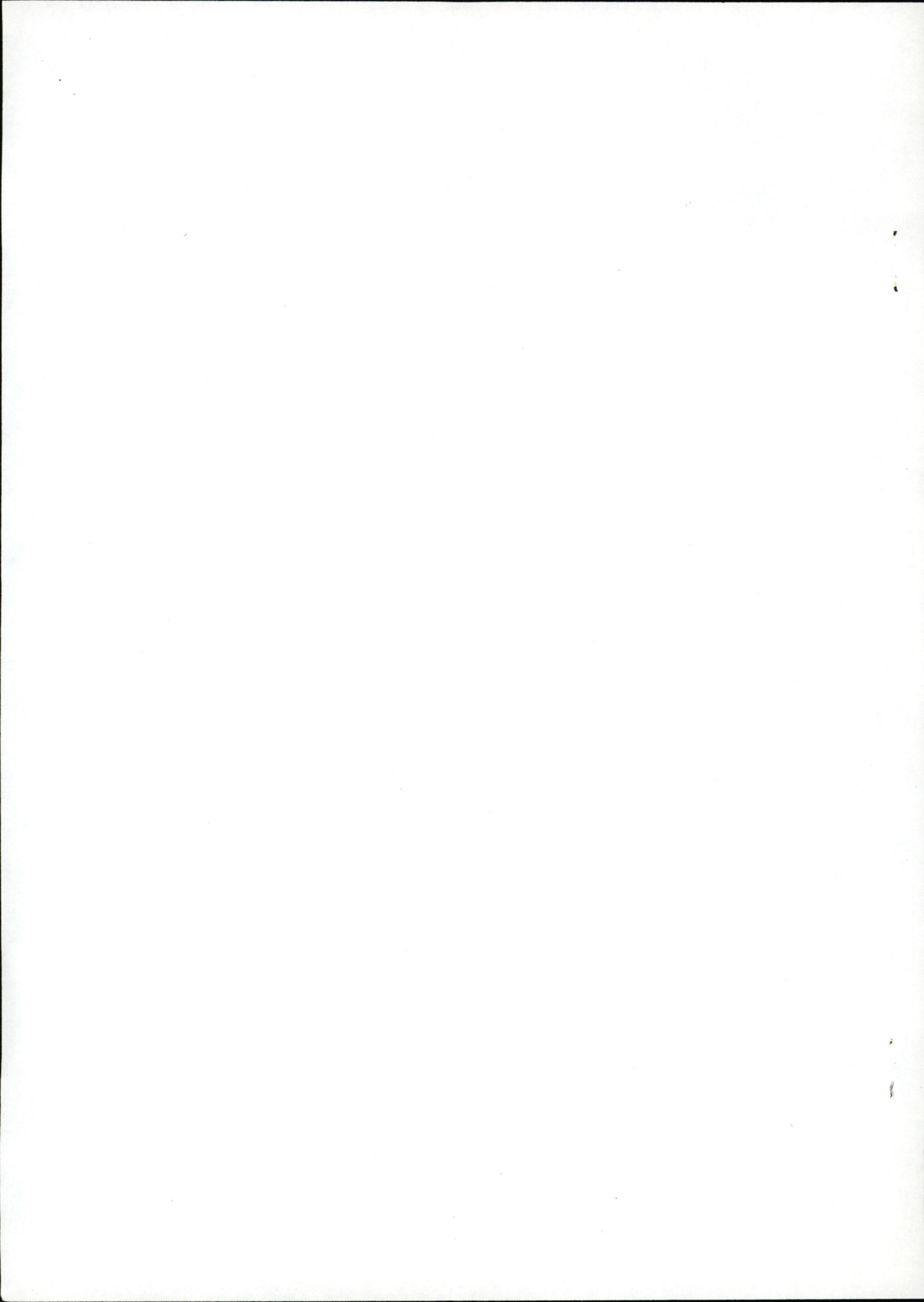
