EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Commons Management Bill 1989.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Local Government Act 1919 as a consequence of and in connection with the enactment of the proposed Commons Management Act 1989.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides that the proposed Act will commence on a day or days to be appointed by proclamation.

Clause 3 gives effect to the Schedule of amendments.

Local Government (Commons Management) Amendment 1989

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Local Government (Commons Management) Amendment Act 1989.

5 Commencement

2. This Act commences on a day or days to be appointed by proclamation.

3. The Local Government Act 1919 is amended as set out in Schedule 1.

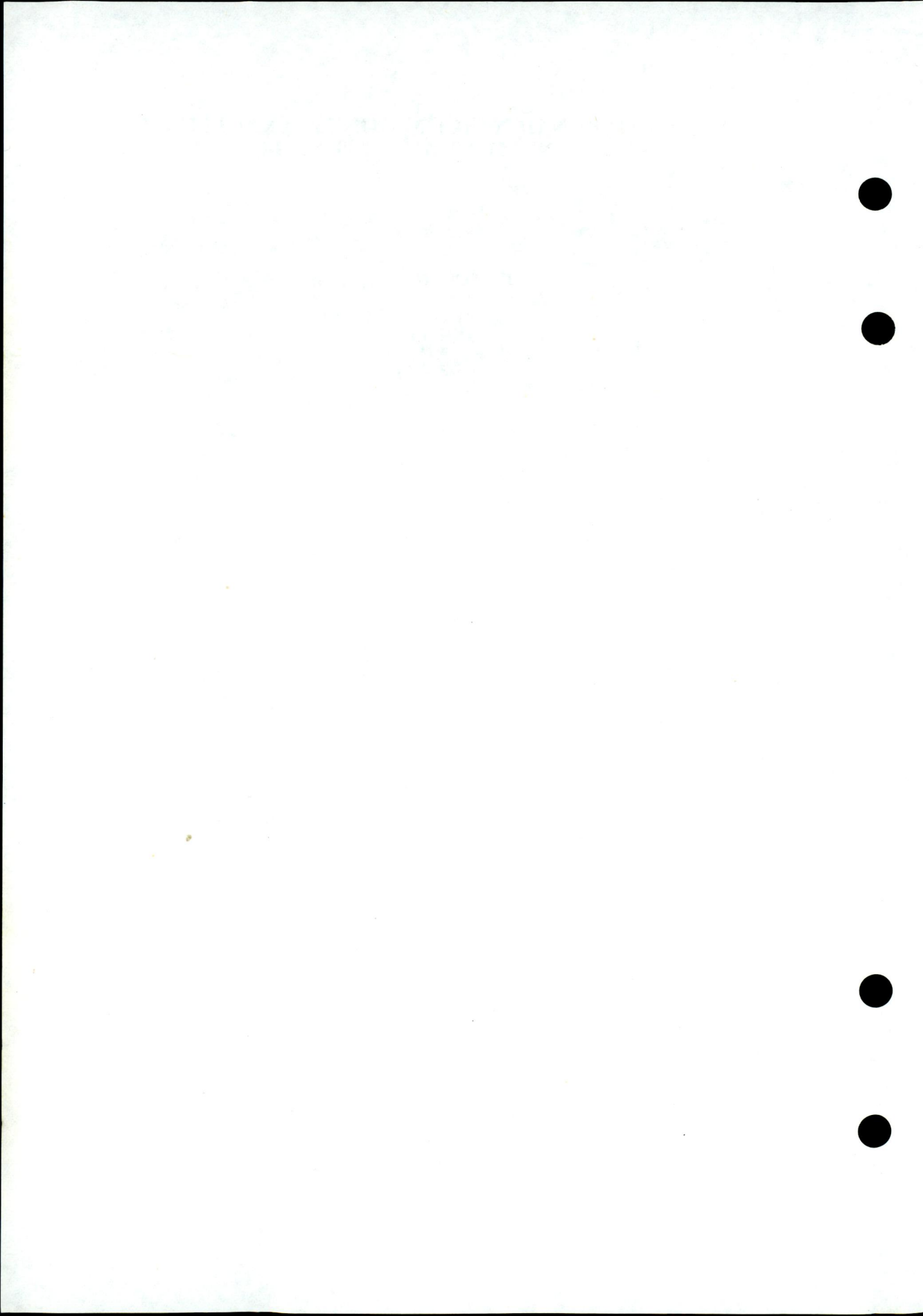

Local Government (Commons Management) Amendment 1989

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

1. This Act may be cited as the Local Government (Commons Management) Amendment Act 1989.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on a day or days to be appointed by proclamation.
