

# Act No. 239, 1989

An Act to amend the Protected Estates Act 1983 to enable the delegation of the Protective Commissioner's functions and to facilitate the investment of money. [Assented to 21 December 1989]

#### The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

#### Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Protected Estates (Amendment) Act 1989.

#### Commencement

2. This Act commences on a day to be appointed by proclamation.

#### Amendment of Protected Estates Act 1983 No. 179

3. The Protected Estates Act 1983 is amended by inserting after section 5 the following sections:

#### **Delegation**

5A. The Protective Commissioner may delegate to the Deputy Protective Commissioner or any member of staff referred to in section 5 (2) the exercise of any of the Protective Commissioner's functions, other than this power of delegation.

# Protective Commissioner to be corporation sole for certain purposes

- 5B. The Protective Commissioner is, by this section, incorporated as a corporation sole under that name for the purposes of:
  - (a) investing money in the common fund and related accounts in accordance with section 58; and
  - (b) exercising any related or incidental functions.
