

# REGULATION REVIEW (AMENDMENT) BILL 1988

NEW SOUTH WALES



## EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The Regulation Review Act 1987 provides for a joint committee of Parliament, known as the Regulation Review Committee to be appointed after the commencement of the first session of each Parliament. The Committee consists of 9 members, 2 from the Legislative Council, and 7 from the Legislative Assembly.

The object of this Bill is to increase the membership of the Committee to 11, with the addition of 2 further members of the Legislative Council as members of the Committee.

---

**Clause 1** specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

**Clause 2** provides for the commencement of the proposed Act.

**Clause 3** provides that a reference to the Principal Act is a reference to the Regulation Review Act 1987.

**Clause 4** is a formal provision that gives effect to the Schedule of amendments.

**Clause 5** is a formal provision that gives effect to the Schedule of savings and transitional provisions.

### SCHEDULE 1—AMENDMENTS

Schedule 1 (1) increases the total membership of the Committee from 9 to 11, by amending the number of members appointed by the Legislative Council from 2 to 4.

Schedule 1 (2) increases the quorum at a meeting of the Committee, from 5 to 7 members.

### SCHEDULE 2—SAVINGS AND TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS

**Clause 1** defines "Committee".

**Clause 2** empowers the Legislative Council to appoint 2 additional members after the commencement of the proposed Act.

**Clause 3** protects the appointment of any member and the election of the Chairman and Vice-Chairman made before commencement of the proposed Act.

**The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:**

**Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the Regulation Review (Amendment) Act 1988.

**5 Commencement**

2. This Act commences on the date of assent.

**Principal Act**

3. The Regulation review Act 1987 is referred to in this Act as the Principal Act.

**10 Amendment of Regulation Review Act 1987 No. 165**

4. The Principal Act is amended as set out in Schedule 1.

**Savings and transitional provisions**

5. Schedule 2 has effect.

**Definition**

1. In this Schedule, “Committee” means the Regulation Review Committee.

**Appointment of additional members**

30 2. The Legislative Council may appoint 2 additional members of the Committee in accordance with the Principal Act, as amended by this Act, as if there were 2 vacancies among the members of the Committee appointed by the Legislative Council.

SCHEDULE 2—SAVINGS AND TRANSITIONAL PROVISIONS—*continued*

**Savings**

3. This Act does not affect the appointment or election to office, or tenure of office, of any member of the Committee holding office immediately before the commencement of this Act.
