EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Bill is cognate with the Appropriation Bill 1991.


The object of this Bill is to amend the Business Franchise Licences (Petroleum Products) Act 1987 to increase the fees to be paid for licences under that Act.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the proposed Act on 1 October 1991.

Clause 3 amends section 40 of the Principal Act so as to increase the fees to be paid for licences under that Act by about 4.9 per cent.

Clause 4 provides that the increased fees are to apply in respect of licences which take effect on or after 1 November 1991.





A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the Business Franchise Licences (Petroleum Products) Act 1987 to increase the fees paid for licences under that Act.

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Business Franchise Licences (Petroleum Products) Amendment Act 1991.

Commencement

2. This Act commences or is taken to have commenced on 1 October 1991.

- 3. The Business Franchise Licences (Petroleum Products) Act 1987 is amended by omitting section 40 (3) and by inserting instead the following subsection:
 - (3) For the purposes of subsection (1), the prescribed proportion is:
 - (a) in respect of motor spirit—8.81 per cent; and
 - (b) in respect of diesel fuel—14.67 per cent.

Application of Act

4. The amendment made by this Act applies to and in respect of a fee for a licence taking effect on or after 1 November 1991.


