
The object of this Bill is to amend the Business Franchise Licences (Petroleum Products) Act 1987 to increase the fees to be paid for licences under that Act.

Clause 3 amends section 40 of the Principal Act so as to increase the fees to be paid for licences under that Act by about 2.5 per cent.


Clause 4 provides that the increased fees are to apply in respect of licences that take effect on or after 1 November 1993.
