EXPLANATORY NOTE


(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The object of this Bill is to amend the Casino Control Act 1992 to prohibit slot machines in a casino.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the proposed Act on the date of assent.

Clause 3 makes the amendment to the Casino Control Act 1992 described above.



A BILL FOR

An Act to amend the Casino Control Act 1992 to prohibit slot machines in a casino.

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Casino Control (Slot Machines) Amendment Act 1993.

5 Commencement

2. This Act commences on the date of assent.

Amendment of Casino Control Act 1992 No. 15

3. The Casino Control Act 1992 is amended by omitting section 8 and by inserting instead the following section:

10 Prohibition on slot machines in casino

- 8. (1) There are to be no slot machines in a casino.
- (2) The casino operator is taken to have contravened a condition of the casino licence if this section is contravened.
 - (3) In this section:
- "slot machine" means gaming equipment comprising a machine operated by the patron by means of wagers made by coin or token or by electronic credit, and includes a poker machine.
