EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)


The object of this Bill is to enable certain Parliamentary Committees to function during the next prorogation of Parliament and during the fourth session of the present Parliament.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides that the proposed Act is to commence on the date of assent.

Clause 3 declares that the Parliamentary Committees mentioned in Schedule 1 to the proposed Act may lawfully sit during the prorogation of the present Parliament and during the fourth session of the present Parliament. The clause also enables the Committees in that period to do all things they might lawfully have done during the third session of the present Parliament. The clause is subject to the powers of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly.

Schedule 1 sets out the Parliamentary Committees continued by the proposed Act.



A BILL FOR

An Act to enable certain Committees of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly to function during the prorogation of Parliament and during the fourth session of the fiftieth Parliament.

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Parliamentary Committees Enabling Act 1993.

5 Commencement

2. This Act commences on the date of assent.

Power to function for an extended period

- 3. (1) It is hereby declared that the Parliamentary Committees mentioned in Schedule 1 may:
- (a) lawfully sit during the period commencing on the termination of the third session of the fiftieth Parliament and ending on the termination of the fourth session of that Parliament; and
 - (b) lawfully do during that period all such things as they might lawfully have done had the third session of that Parliament continued throughout that period.
 - (2) Nothing in subsection (1) affects or alters any power of the Legislative Council or Legislative Assembly, and it is hereby declared that the operation of that subsection is subject to any such power and the exercise of that power.




