

Act No. 52, 1994

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Fund towards the services of the Legislature for the year 1994–1995. [Assented to 28 September 1994]

Parliamentary Supply Act 1994 No. 52

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Parliamentary Supply Act 1994.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on the date of assent.

\$8,870,000 may be issued out of the Consolidated Fund for recurrent services

3. Out of the Consolidated Fund there is hereby appropriated and may be issued and applied the sum of \$8,870,000 to defray the expenses of the Legislature during the months of October and November of the financial year ending 30 June 1995, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of that year.

\$334,000 may be issued out of the Consolidated Fund for capital works and services

4. Out of the Consolidated Fund there is hereby appropriated and may be issued and applied the sum of \$334,000 to meet the capital works and services expenditure of the Legislature during the months of October and November of the financial year ending 30 June 1995, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of that year.

Treasurer's authority to pay sums appropriated

5. The Treasurer may issue and pay the sums appropriated by this Act in such manner and in such proportions as may be necessary in the public interest to provide for expenditure for the purposes referred to in sections 3 and 4.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)


This Bill is cognate with the Supply Bill 1994.

Pending the enactment of the annual Appropriation Act, the Treasurer is authorised, under section 25 of the Public Finance and Audit Act 1983, to make payments from the Consolidated Fund during the first 3 months of the new financial year (July, August and September) in respect of regularly recurring services and ordinary contingencies. Those payments are, on the passing of the Parliamentary Appropriation Act, to be regarded as having been made out of money appropriated by that Act.

The object of this Bill is to make provision, pending the enactment of this year's Parliamentary Appropriation Act, for the Treasurer to make payments from the Consolidated Fund during the months of October and November in respect of regularly recurring services and ordinary contingencies of the Legislature as follows:

The Parliamentary Appropriation Act will contain a provision to the effect that amounts expended under the Parliamentary Supply Act are to be regarded as having been made out of money appropriated by the Parliamentary Appropriation Act.



An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Fund towards the services of the Legislature for the year 1994–1995.

Parliamentary Supply 1994

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Parliamentary Supply Act 1994.

Commencement

5 This Act commences on the date of assent. 2.

\$8,870,000 may be issued out of the Consolidated Fund for recurrent services

3. Out of the Consolidated Fund there is hereby appropriated and may be issued and applied the sum of \$8,870,000 to defray the expenses of the 10 Legislature during the months of October and November of the financial year ending 30 June 1995, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of that year.

\$334,000 may be issued out of the Consolidated Fund for capital works and services

4. Out of the Consolidated Fund there is hereby appropriated and may 15 be issued and applied the sum of \$334,000 to meet the capital works and services expenditure of the Legislature during the months of October and November of the financial year ending 30 June 1995, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of that 20 year.

Treasurer's authority to pay sums appropriated

5. The Treasurer may issue and pay the sums appropriated by this Act in such manner and in such proportions as may be necessary in the public interest to provide for expenditure for the purposes referred to in sections 25 3 and 4.
