PRESERVATION OF CANTERBURY HOSPITAL BILL 1994

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The object of this Bill is to ensure the retention of the Canterbury Hospital and of the services provided at or through that hospital.

Clause 1 specifies the short title to the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the proposed Act to be taken to have commenced on 1 September 1994.

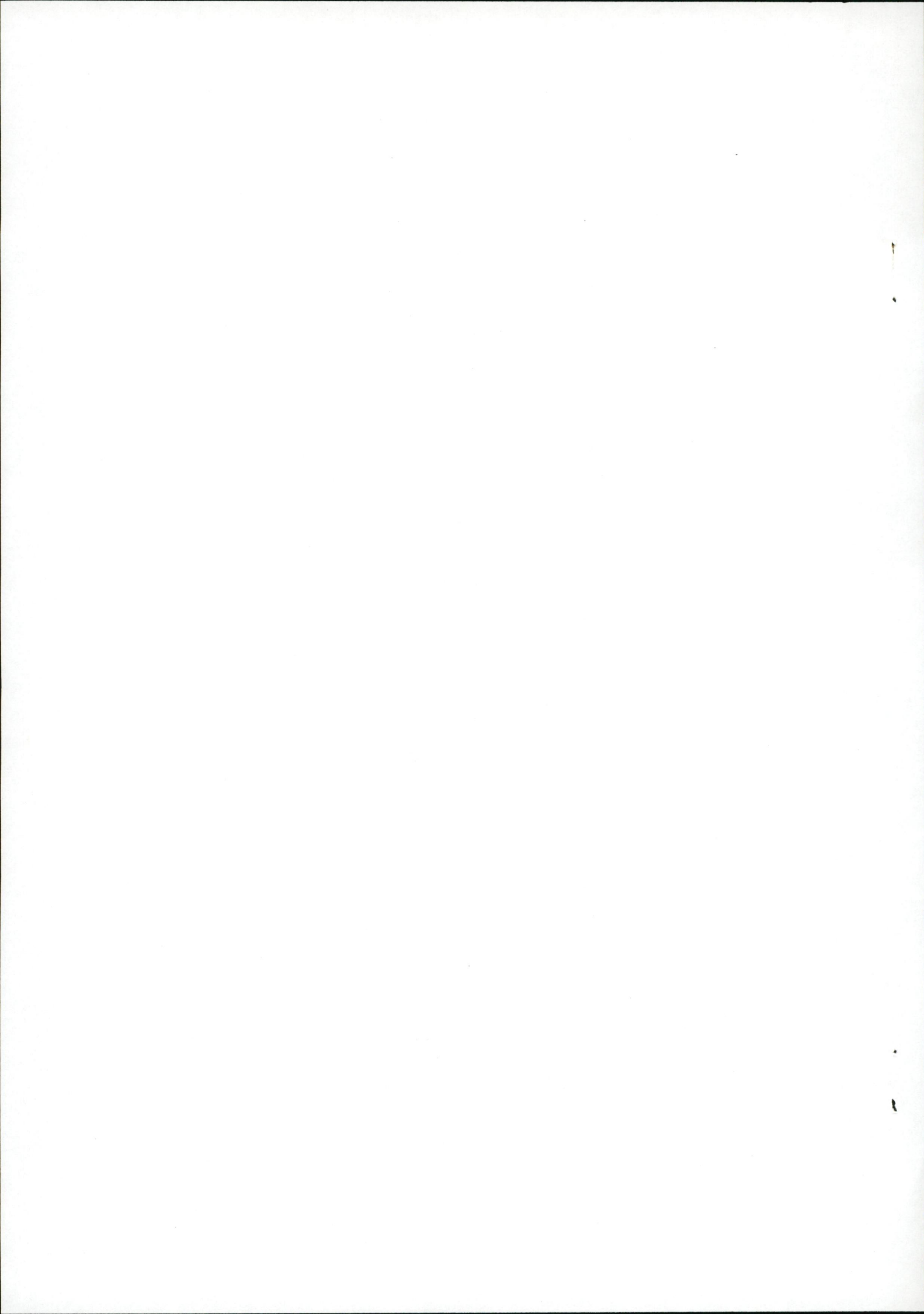
Clause 3 prohibits the closure of the Canterbury Hospital.

Clause 4 provides that the nature and level of services provided at or through the Canterbury Hospital as at 1 September 1994 must not be reduced.

Clause 5 provides that anything done in contravention of the proposed Act is void.

Clause 6 provides that the proposed Act is to have effect despite any other law to the contrary.

Clause 7 provides for the expiry of the proposed Act on 31 March 1999.

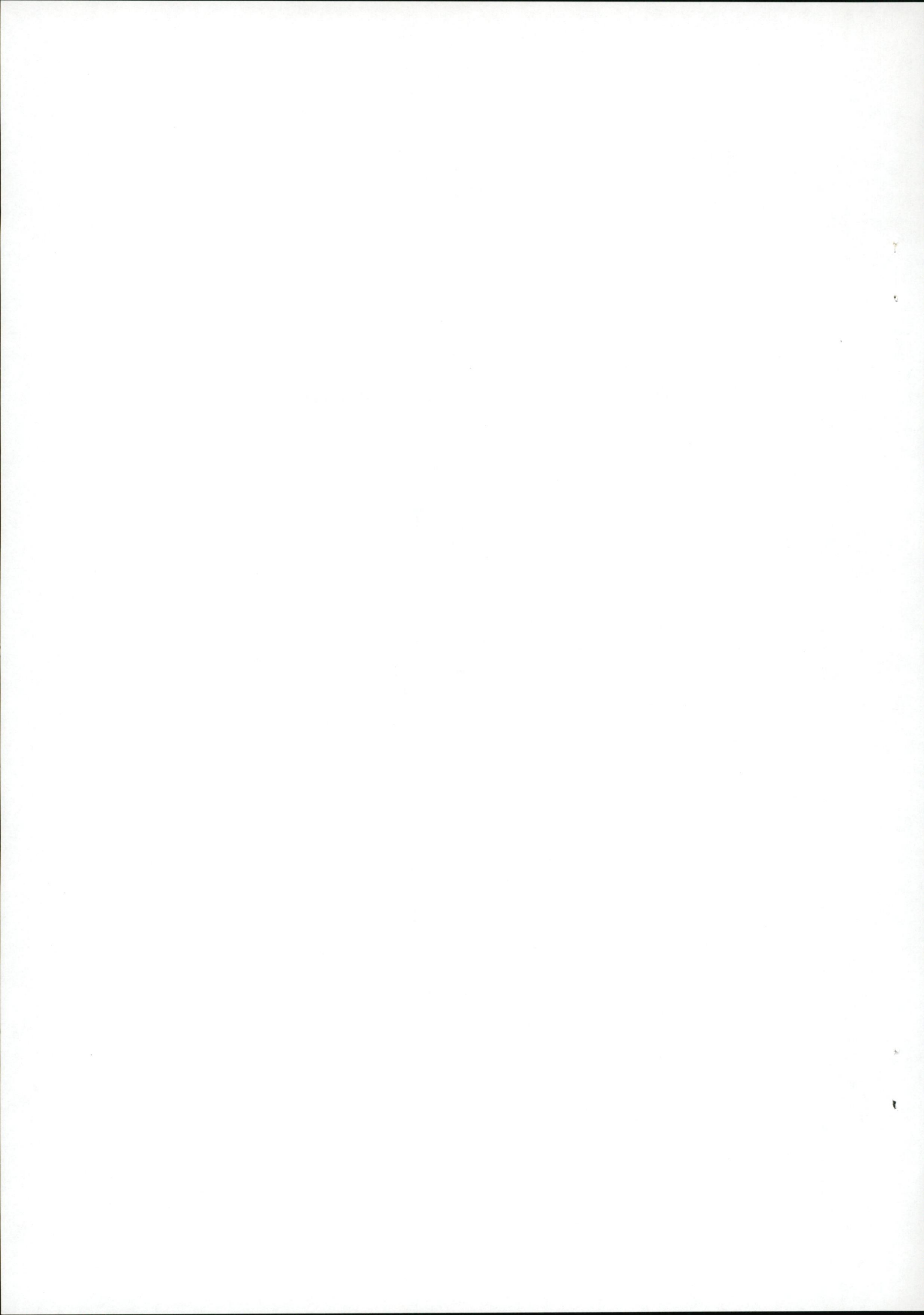

A BILL FOR

An Act to ensure the retention of the Canterbury Hospital and of the services provided at or through that hospital.

Preservation of Canterbury Hospital 1994

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Preservation of Canterbury Hospital Act 1994.

5 **Commencement**

2. This Act is taken to have commenced on 1 September 1994.

Prohibition on closure of the Canterbury Hospital

3. The Canterbury Hospital must not be closed.

Prohibition on reduction of services of the Canterbury Hospital

10 4. The nature and level of services provided at or through the Canterbury Hospital as at 1 September 1994 must not be reduced.

Effect of contravention of this Act

5. Anything done in contravention of this Act is void.

Application of this Act

15 6. This Act has effect despite any other law to the contrary.

Expiry of this Act

7. This Act expires on 31 March 1999.
