# **Banks and Bank Holidays Amendment Bill 1995**

## **Explanatory note**

This explanatory note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament.

### **Overview of Bill**

The object of this Bill is to amend the *Banks and Bank Holidays Act 1912* so as to appoint 15 August 1995 as a public holiday to be observed throughout New South Wales to commemorate and celebrate the fiftieth anniversary of the end of the Second World War.

### **Outline of provisions**

**Clause 1** sets out the name (also called the short title) of the proposed Act.

**Clause 2** provides that the proposed Act will commence on the date of its assent.

**Clause 3** amends the *Banks and Bank Holidays Act 1912* so as to achieve the object referred to above.

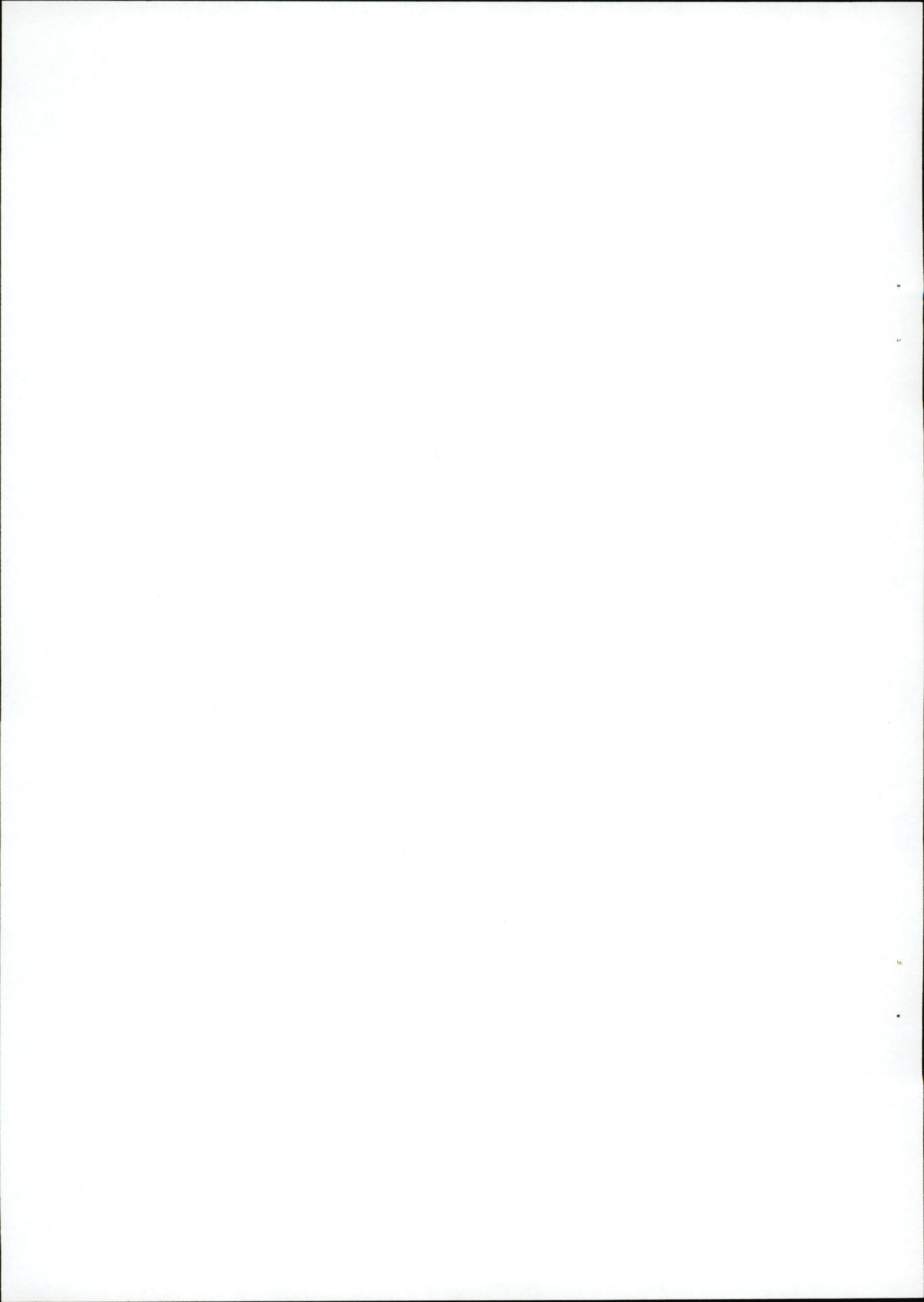

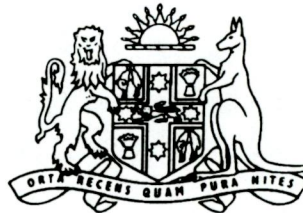

**The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:**

**1 Name of Act**

This Act is the *Banks and Bank Holidays Amendment Act 1995*.

**2 Commencement**

This Act commences on the date of assent to this Act. 5

**3 Amendment of Banks and Bank Holidays Act 1912 No 43**

The Banks and Bank Holidays Act 1912 is amended by inserting in Part 1 of the Fourth Schedule, in appropriate order, the following words:

The fifteenth day of August 1995. 10
